Our second scripture reading from St. Peter's letter this weekend speaks directly to our current situation and how to live as disciples amidst this global pandemic and necessary "shelter in place" to protect lives. Our faith certainly is being "tested by fire" just as it was courageously for the first disciples amidst persecution and death.


These challenging times are calling us to live differently as disciples. Coordinating the livestream of Holy Week services and Easter Sunday was an eventful and intense learning curve of logistics, equipment and quick response from our staff and volunteers. Thank you for your patience and persistence as we resolved the various technical issues involved in uploading video from our

church – while every other church in the world was trying to do at the same times!

### Livestream Liturgy

The first disciples celebrated the Lord's presence in their homes (*Acts 2:46*) much as we are now learning to do, finding simple ways to create holy spaces to view and participate in livestreamed Mass. We are hearing poignant stories of how we are "remembering" family mealtimes as more regular and necessary time together in person again. How is God challenging us to restore relationships and know the importance of sacred space and common prayer? These are lessons to pay attention to what God is calling us to be and do as disciples.

We will continue to celebrate and livestream Mass each Saturday at 5:00 PM with the recording available later that evening and throughout the week for you to view and participate. Each week we will also post a PDF Order of Worship so you can follow and join in prayer and song. Together with our Mercy Teams and St. Vincent de Paul outreach efforts available for your participation (see page 5) – *may we prove to be for praise, glory, and honor at the revelation of Jesus Christ.*

## Liturgy, Music, and Prayer

### Praying the Divine Mercy Chaplet

Today is Divine Mercy Sunday. The **Chaplet of the Divine Mercy** is a devotion to the **Divine Mercy** based on the Christological apparitions of Jesus reported by Saint Faustina Kowalska (1905–1938), known as “the Apostle of **Mercy**.” She was a Polish religious sister of the Congregation of the Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy and canonized as a Catholic saint in 2000 by then-Pope John Paul II.

### How to Pray the Chaplet of Divine Mercy

#### Optional Opening Prayers:

(1) You expired, Jesus, but the source of life gushed forth for souls, and the ocean of mercy opened up for the whole world.

(2) O Fount of Life, unfathomable Divine Mercy, envelop the whole world and empty Yourself out upon us.

*(Repeat 3 times)* O Blood and Water, which gushed forth from the Heart of Jesus as a fountain of Mercy for us, I trust in You!

#### Our Father, Hail Mary and the Apostle’s Creed

**For each of the five decades** *(On each “Our Father” bead of the rosary, pray)*



Eternal Father, I offer you the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your Dearly Beloved Son, Our Lord, Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.

*(On each of the 10 “Hail Mary” beads, pray)* For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

**Concluding prayer** *(Repeat 3 times)* Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

#### Optional Closing Prayer

Eternal God, in whom mercy is endless and the treasury of compassion inexhaustible, look kindly upon us and increase Your mercy in us, that in difficult moments we might not despair nor become despondent, but with great confidence submit ourselves to Your holy will, which is Love and Mercy itself.

### Returning and Searching Catholics: Know God More Personally Through Faith

Are you really “awake” to your Catholic Faith? Is God in your life now? Like many Catholics, your faith may have been passed down to you by your parents. Maybe you even attended Catholic Schools. Did your faith development stop once you reached adulthood?

### Respect Life

#### Divine Mercy Sunday

Each year, on the Second Sunday of Easter, the Church celebrates the Sunday of Divine Mercy. Mankind’s need for the message of Divine Mercy took on dire urgency in the 20th century, when civilization began again to lose the understanding of the sanctity and inherent dignity of every human life.

Since the legalization of abortion in our country, millions of women, men and families have been hurt by abortion. By the age of 45, as many as 1 in 3 women have had an abortion, and a similar number of men and family members have been involved. Many inaccurately believe that abortion is “the unforgivable sin.” They need to hear that God forgives every sin of a repentant heart, even the sin of abortion.
