## Transformed by the Body of Christ

*“The cup of blessing that we bless, is it not a sharing in the blood of Christ? The bread that we break, is it not a sharing in the body of Christ? Because there is one bread, we who are many are one body, for we all partake of the one bread.”*

~ 1 Corinthians 10:16-17 ~

St. Paul had heard reports that the early Christian community in Corinth was experiencing divisiveness because some more privileged members of the community arrived early to the Eucharist and took all the best places and food, while those later to arrive – usually workers and slaves – felt excluded and hungry. His message to them was emphatic: the Body of Christ is not just what we share and consume, but must be what we become as Body of Christ in the world.

This weekend, as we celebrate the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ (in Latin: *Corpus Christi*) the Real Presence of the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ in the elements of the Eucharist, we are faced with similar issues in our own day and time. Just as Corpus Christi processions take the Holy Eucharist to the streets in traditions around the world and locally, so we might ask: How are we being transformed into the Body of Christ within our families, communities, country and world?



Kimi and I had the graced opportunity in 2014 to visit Orvieto, Italy, during a pilgrimage we led to Assisi and Rome (photo of the hilltop shrine). Legend has it that a village priest from nearby Bolsena and congregation witnessed a Eucharistic miracle of a bleeding consecrated host.

The corporal linen that was stained is enshrined in the Orvieto Cathedral. I was grateful for the moment to reflect on my own belief in the Real Presence, and challenge to live that conviction each day.

During these quarantined days, now months, because of my role and work here at the parish, I have had the graced opportunity to continue partaking in the Holy Eucharist as we have provided the livestream Masses for you. I don't take the privilege for granted, knowing the hunger and longing to receive the Body of Christ that so many of you have shared with me in emails and messages. I just pray that I am a worthy servant in these difficult and challenging times.

I am greatly blessed to witness the many ways that our parish has become Eucharist for many hungry people through our Sack Lunch Meals of Mercy each week, and through the continued amazing efforts of our St. Vincent de Paul Society. May the Holy Spirit continue to transform our parish into the Body of Christ in our world.



## ONLINE GIVING IN 3 EASY STEPS

If you are already using online giving skip step 1 and 2. (If you forgot your user ID or password click the forgot button and a new password will be emailed to you.)

### STEP 1 - REGISTER

- From OLL website [www.ollparish.com](http://www.ollparish.com)
- Click "Giving" in top right navigation bar
- Click on "Give Now:
- Click on **CREATE A NEW ACCOUNT**.
- Fill in the information boxes that contain a red asterisk. Make sure to write down your User ID and Password (put in a secure and safe place.)
- **Submit. You will receive an email to confirm your information.**



### STEP 2 – SET UP PAYMENT METHOD

- Now log into your account, click on **MY PAYMENT METHOD**.
- You will need to **ADD NEW BANK ACCOUNT** (if using your checking account) **OR ADD NEW CREDIT CARD** (if using your credit card).
- Provide all the information requested. Then click **SUBMIT**.

### STEP 3 – SET UP DONATION

**OPTIONS:** You can choose multiple funds (RE, Building Maintenance, Svdp)

- Now return to **MANAGE MY ACCOUNT** and choose **GIVE A NEW GIFT**.
- Choose **OFFERTORY** (fund), then select gift type **RECURRING**.
- Select payment and frequency and start date.
- Select the account (check or credit card), then enter amount and frequency.
- Click **NEXT** (at the bottom of the page)
- In the **CONFIRM MY GIFTS** window, review the details to insure all is correct. Click **SUBMIT**.

### Grateful for the Holy Eucharist

This weekend, as we celebrate the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ, we are reminded that the word “Eucharist” actually means “giving thanks.” As we partake in the Holy Eucharist – even Spiritual Communion in these quarantine days – we are invited to give thanks for Christ’s real presence, and for the gift of life and faith we receive. Many saints through the years have reflected that at its core, all prayer comes down to an *attitude of gratitude*. In prayer, we are grateful to God through, with, and in our life in Christ.
