





The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary

My soul proclaims the greatness of the Lord.

~ Luke 1:46 ~

This weekend, August 15 and 16, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary into Heaven. Uniquely this year, because the Holy Day falls on a Saturday, the solemnity can take precedence over the 20th Sunday in Ordinary Time. Therefore, our Saturday Masses at 8:30 AM and livestream at 5:00 PM, as well as Sunday Masses at 9:00 and 11:00 AM will all celebrate Mary's Assumption into heaven, our patroness as Our Lady of the Lake. To celebrate, we will have live music at all Masses this weekend to accompany our liturgical prayer.

One of the most often recited or sung prayers to the Blessed Mother, in addition to the *Hail Mary*, is the *Salve Regina – or Hail, Holy Queen*. The *Salve Regina* is traditionally sung at Evening Prayer (or Compline) in the time from the Saturday before Trinity Sunday until the Friday before the first Sunday of Advent. The *Hail Holy Queen* is also the final prayer of the Rosary.

The prayer was composed during the Middle Ages and originally appeared in Latin. Though traditionally attributed to the eleventh-century German monk Hermann of Reichenau, the musical composer is considered anonymous. Traditionally it has been sung in Latin and many translations exist. Here is the version that is presented by the United States Catholic Bishops Conference:

Hail, holy Queen, Mother of mercy,
our life, our sweetness, and our hope.
To you we cry, the children of Eve;
to you we send up our sighs,
mourning and weeping in this land of exile.
Turn, then, most gracious advocate,
your eyes of mercy toward us;
lead us home at the end
and show us the blessed fruit of your womb, Jesus:
O clement, O loving, O sweet Virgin Mary.
Amen.



Sack Lunch Meals of Mercy

The need throughout the Portland Metro has increased, both with food insecure families and the unsheltered. Mercy Teams will continue our Sack Lunch Meals of Mercy Outreach through the month of July.

To date parishioners have donated and delivered 20,000 sack lunch meals of mercy, and another 135 family meals, each serving 5 to 6 individuals. All of this since the end of March.

Walking With Moms In Need?

Walking with Moms in Need is a year of service where Catholic parishes and communities “walk in the shoes” of local pregnant and parenting women in need. Everyone should know how to help moms in difficult circumstances.



While not trying to turn Catholic parishes into pregnancy centers, we can support local pregnancy centers where they exist, and we can also find and share other resources with pregnant and parenting women.

Week 21: Did You Know?? Road2Hope Maternity Home in Beaverton “exists to meet the physical, emotional, and spiritual needs of pregnant young women and their children by providing a safe nurturing community.” Women ages 18 and up enter the home at any point during their pregnancy and may stay up to a year after their baby is born. Road2Hope offers an ongoing aftercare program to support women as they move out of the home. Find more information at road2hopepdx.org. The home is a life-giving resource to support during this year of Walking with Moms in Need.
