
In the Midst of the Storm

These are unsettling times to say the very least. It seems that one catastrophe leads to another on a global, national, statewide and urban level. Now these statewide fires are touching all of our lives. While at the same time families continue to face the “normal” personal struggles of illness, addiction, heart ache and loss of loved ones. It is often asked: Can this year get any worse?

One of the moments in the Gospel that comes to mind is *The Calming of the Storm* in the Gospel of St. Matthew (Matthew 8:23-27):

As the storm on the Sea of Galilee was raging the disciples were terrified they would drown! They couldn't believe that Jesus was sleeping through it all on a cushion in the boat. What I find consoling is that Jesus sleeps not because he doesn't care, but because he is not afraid; He is at peace. When they wake him he doesn't start by calming the storm, but first – while the storm is raging – he addresses their fears and their faith. This is not to chastise them, but to remind them of his fundamental message: Do not be afraid, have faith. Then he calms the storm. But notice that he says to have faith *during* the storm.

Storms happen. Fires happen. Political turmoil happens. Pandemics happen. Usually they don't happen all at once, but, apparently, sometimes they do.



But the truth remains: God is still with us. He will give us what we need.

He will help us look to each other; to help each other; to depend upon each other. God gave us each other and gave us our faith and always says: “Do not be afraid.”

Here is a favorite prayer of mine that you may find helpful.

Be at Peace.

Do not look forward in fear to the changes in life;

Rather, look to them with full hope that, as they arise,

God, whose very own you are, will lead you safely through all things; and when you cannot stand it, God will carry you in His arms.

Do not fear what may happen tomorrow.

The same loving Father who cares for you today will care for you tomorrow and everyday.

Either he will shield you from suffering or He will give you unfailing strength to bear it.

Be at peace then and put aside all anxious thoughts and imaginings. Amen.





Singing our Responses during Mass

This weekend and through the remainder of Ordinary Time, we will begin singing a new musical setting for the Alleluia and sung responses during the Eucharistic prayer at Mass. The *Mass of St. Mary Magdalene* is a beautiful and melodic setting by Sarah Hart – a very gifted and talented composer whose songs appear in our *Breaking Bread* and *Spirit & Song* hymnals. We sing many of her compositions at other parts of the Mass. Sarah is now the most published Catholic woman composer in the world and played this setting during a papal Mass in 2019.

Mass settings are the sung acclamations that give our response and participation to the prayers the priest says at the altar. They are the most important parts of the Mass we sing:

The acclamations of the Eucharistic Liturgy and other rites arise from the whole gathered assembly's assent to God's Word and action. The Eucharistic acclamations include the Gospel Acclamation (Alleluia), the Sanctus (Holy, Holy), the Memorial Acclamation (Mystery of Faith), and the Great Amen.

~ Sing to the Lord: Music in Divine Worship #115a ~

Since Easter, we have been using the *Mass of Renewal* for our responses. This is our most familiar Mass setting and the one we use for Christmas and Easter season each year. During quarantine in our livestream Masses, we felt it important to continue using a familiar set of responses. However, now that our limited capacity at Mass condition continues, we hope this new setting will invite you into the Eucharistic prayers with new attention and response. They have a very intuitive melodic structure that we think you'll easily follow and appreciate. Let us know what you think. We welcome your comments.

We'll continue using the *Glory to God* from the *Mass of Renewal* for now, since that response takes a little longer to learn. And we will again use the *Belmont Mass* (English chant) for Advent and the Latin *Chant Mass* during Lent. Each of these adds its unique musical characteristics for different seasons of the Church year.

Our goal is that each child, from preschool through fifth grade, can know, love, and follow Jesus in their life.

This fall, we will offer online learning to children enrolled in Life Kids and First Sacraments.

Sack Lunch Meals of Mercy

Sack Lunch Meals of Mercy has now delivered over 37,000 sack lunches and meals to food insecure families, the unsheltered throughout Portland, Long Term Care Facilities, and the Boys & Girls Clubs of Portland.

We plan to continue in the name of Jesus Christ, through October, if the support is there. We know the need remains.

Sack Lunches are delivered with a sandwich to 7 missions around Portland that serve the unsheltered or food insecure families.

We need 50 volunteers each Sunday and Monday to help make sandwiches, organize sacks for missions or help deliver to missions Sunday and Monday mornings.



Sack Lunch Pledge – Donate any number of sack lunches for a week or more. Our goal is 1,450 per week – Lunches to include 16 oz bottle of water, granola bar, fruit/apple sauce cup, bag of chips, plastic spoon, and napkin (other volunteers make the sandwiches). Drop off Sunday morning outside the parish hall 9:00 AM to 10:30 AM. No need to leave your car, we safely collect.

Street Ministry to The Unsheltered

Every 4th Saturday of the Month – The number of volunteers is limited to insure social distancing. Next dates Saturday, September 26 and Saturday, October 24.

Join us in serving 50 to 80 unsheltered friends on the 4th Saturday of every month. We meet in the parish hall at 7:30 AM to heat breakfast burritos and make up 80 ham & cheese sandwiches. We depart at 9:00 AM and arrive at our first stop by 9:30 AM under the West Linn Arch Bridge. We make three stops and are done by 11:45 AM.
