Welcome Luke Brooks

This weekend we welcome Luke Brooks as our new Director of Youth Ministry for Our Lady of the Lake. Luke and his wife, Lex, and their young daughter, Lennon, arrived this week from southern California where Luke has been serving as Confirmation Director and LifeTeen Mass Music Coordinator at St. Philip the Apostle Church in Pasadena. They are looking forward to the cooler temps of the Pacific Northwest and joining our parish community here.

Originally from England, Luke says he will not mind our rainy seasons, though he admits it will be more of an adjustment for Lex who is a California native. Luke came to the United States eleven years ago to serve as Youth Pastor at South Bay Seventh Day Adventist Church in Redondo Beach, and later at Vallejo Drive Seventh Day Adventist Church in Glendale. His journey and conversion to Catholicism is a remarkable and inspiring story and one he will likely share as he reaches out to the youth and young adults of Our Lady of the Lake in their own faith formation.

Following an extensive national search and interviews of multiple candidates, we are delighted to welcome Luke with his experience and education to our Faith Formation team. Luke holds a Master of Divinity degree from Fuller Theological Seminary in Pasadena and a recently completed Master of Arts in Philosophy from Holy Apostles Seminary in Cromwell, Connecticut. Additionally, his undergrad degree in music from the Academy of Contemporary Music in Guildford, England, might be a clue to the name of their daughter as he mentions in a short, Introduction video you can view on our parish Youth Ministry page at www.ollparish.com/youth.

Luke is embracing the challenge of providing youth ministry for our middle and high school aged teens in this COVID-19 restricted time and will be reaching out to youth and parents in the coming weeks to establish connections and opportunities. 

The Month of the Rosary

October is the Month of the Rosary, an annual opportunity to pray and give more attention to this contemplative spiritual practice. The rosary can be recited in group settings, with one or more persons taking turns leading individual decades. As an individual prayer, the rosary is an any-time, any-where chance to pray and meditate on God's continuing presence in your life.

The exact origin of the Rosary as a prayer is less than clear and subject to debate among scholars. The use of knotted prayer ropes in Christianity goes back to the Desert Fathers in the 3rd and early 4th centuries. These counting devices were used for prayers such as the Jesus prayer in Christian monasticism. The period after the First Council of Ephesus in 431 witnessed gradual growth in the use of Marian prayers during the Middle Ages by lay people as well.

According to some Catholic traditions, the Rosary was given to Saint Dominic in a vision of the Blessed Virgin Mary and it was then promoted by Blessed Allan de la Roche. Some historians see a more gradual development for the Rosary, in that the repetition of Marian prayers which form the basis of the Rosary needed counting devices, which resulted in the modern form of the Rosary prayed on beads.


The practice of meditation during the praying of the Hail Mary's is attributed to Dominic of Prussia, a 15th-century Carthusian monk, who called it the "Life of Jesus Rosary." The Christian victory at the Battle of Lepanto in 1571 was attributed to the praying of the Rosary by many Europeans based on the request of Pope Pius V and eventually resulted in his establishing the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary in 1569. In 2002 Pope John Paul II introduced the Luminous Mysteries.

Why Pray the Rosary?

There are many spiritual approaches to praying the rosary both individually and in groups. For example, a number of parishioners who attend our morning Masses at OLL frequently recite the rosary together after Mass as an extension of their celebration of the Holy Eucharist. Praying the rosary together as a group or as a family also provides the daily or weekly discipline to maintain a prayer practice.

Some people find that praying the Rosary in the evening or just before bed helps to provide a perspective on the day and a sense of peace about life's difficult moments. Many people find that praying the rosary while driving – either a longer distance, or in commuting to or from work, allows time to re-focus their heart and mind and renew their spirit for the day. It's also pretty difficult to succumb to "road rage" while reciting a Hail Mary!

Pamphlets on "How to Pray the Rosary" are always available in the back of our church or from the parish office. If it has been some time since you have prayed the Rosary, consider this month of October as a new opportunity to meet Our Lord and Our Blessed Mother in prayer. They are waiting for you!
