This Sunday we begin the season of Advent – a time of *waiting* for the Lord. In the Gospel of Mark, we hear Jesus caution the disciples to "Be watchful! Be alert!" Certainly, the events of the past eleven months have given us new

understanding of the importance of being alert – for we do not know the day or the time. As wildfires and storms threatened our safety this fall – we *waited* for first responders to bring relief. As the pandemic still ravages the world – we *wait* for a vaccine to be the promise of safety. In all these things we *dare to hope* that God is with us.

Yes, we believe that Jesus already was born in human history, and lived,

died and was raised from the dead, as we proclaim in the Nicene Creed each Sunday. But we take time each liturgical year during Advent to focus on preparing – for Jesus, the Christ to return and gather the whole world unto Himself. We are *waiting*.

Advent, then, is an opportunity to wait for Our Lord with fresh eyes and an open heart. We might ask: *In the midst of*

all life's uncertainty this year, how have I still experienced God's presence in my life? Where have I seen God at work in my family, in my work or school, in unexpected places? How can I be the hands and feet of Christ as a disciple?

Praying Advent at Mass and at Home

At Sunday Mass during Advent, to focus this theme of waiting for Christ, we will dim the lights for the Entrance

procession as the candles of the Advent wreath are lit and we sing the Entrance Chant above with that week's antiphon. We will sing the Penitential Act (Lord, have mercy) and begin using the *Belmont Mass*, an English chant setting, for our responses during Mass.

Since we cannot all gather in church, it provides an opportunity to renew the importance of celebrating faith in our

homes and in our families or extended community. Our Faith Formation staff have now provided curated resources and links (articles, videos, and more) on our parish website for children, youth, parents, families and adults that reflect our Advent theme. We encourage you to explore these new ways to grow deeper in faith and to pray together at home, individually and as families.

Thank you to everyone who so lovingly participated in the Thanksgiving Box program. Through your generosity we were able to provide dinners for 129 families.

Because the Thanksgiving Box program went so well, this year for the **Christmas Box Program** we will follow a similar format due to the limited space in the Church Hall, as well as wanting to limit social contact. Your participation in this worthwhile project will benefit many struggling families in the Portland Metro area to have a great Christmas meal.

The empty boxes will be available for pick up on Saturday, December 12 from 4:30 to 6:30 PM *or* Sunday, December 13 from 8:30 AM to 12:30 PM. The filled boxes will be brought back on Saturday, December 19 for same day distribution. You will be able to go to the Parish website to sign up for any of the following options:

Option 1—**Pick Up, Fill, & Deliver:** Pick up your box and shopping list on the weekend of December 12 & 13; return on the morning of Saturday, December 19 to receive the **name and address of a family for delivery**. We will provide a \$20 grocery gift card to accompany the meal you provided.

Option 2 — **Pick Up & Fill the box only:** If you would rather not make a delivery, you may sign up to return a filled box only.

Option 3 — **Deliver**: Volunteer as a delivery driver. We will need some extra drivers for those who are unable to make the delivery.

We look forward to having you join us in our Christmas outreach.

Celebrating Advent 2020

Lighting the candles of the Advent wreath each week will remind us that the Light of Christ dispels any personal or communal darkness. Unfortunately, availability to attend Mass will continue to be restricted. (Thank you for your patience!) We ask that you please continue to follow the sign-up process and compliance with safety protocols: the necessity of wearing of masks, and maintaining physical distancing when you come to Mass. We keep all our schedule information up to date on our parish website, <u>ollparish.com</u>. If you don't have a computer to get online and register, always feel free to call the parish office during daytime hours for assistance (503-636-7687).

Daily and Sunday Mass.

The good news of Fr. Suresh Amalraj's return from India has allowed us to now offer a daily 8:30 AM Mass Monday through Saturday, and an additional 6:00 PM Mass on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays. Tuesday evening is now our OLL School Mass – a wonderful opportunity <u>for all parents with children</u> to consider attending online with its child-focused homily each week.

All Masses are livestreamed, and now on Sunday mornings we also open the parish hall where people can watch on-screen for 9:00 and 11:30 AM Mass. This allows more parishioners the opportunity to receive Holy Communion. Please be attentive to which location you are registering for when you sign up.

Confession Times.

We will not be able to offer our Advent Reconciliation services with multiple confessors available this year. Therefore, we are providing additional times for individual confession during the first three weeks of December on Wednesdays and Thursdays at 7:00 PM (after Mass), as well as on Saturday mornings from 9:30-10:30 AM after morning Mass. We are not able to offer confession on Saturday afternoons currently since that is when we set up for livestream Mass.

Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception

Tuesday, December 8 is the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception – a Holy Day. Even though the obligation to attend Mass in person is suspended, we will have three livestreamed Masses for you to choose at 8:30 and 11:00 AM and at 6:00 PM. Join us to pray for Our Blessed Mother's intercession in healing our world.

First Friday Eucharistic Adoration, December 4, 9:30 AM to 8:00 PM

All are welcome to stop by the church to spend time with our Lord anytime Friday, December 4 between 9:30 AM and 8:00 PM. No sign up necessary.

Lord is an escape from the noise of the world. Think of this time as visiting with your best friend, sitting quietly and enjoying being in each other's company. It is a sacred time not just to talk to the Lord, but also listening to what He wants to tell you.

No pre-registration required but the church will be limited to 25 people at a time; please sign-in on arrival. Masks and social distancing are to be observed.




