We have much to complain about... The pandemic, racial injustice, the economy, the environment, the politics, and the list goes on. These are *very* important matters and these should be discussed and pondered and acted upon.

But if we focus only on the problems, we end up ignoring the ever-present hope. *The HOPE* is the key to everything.

The Holy Family had much to complain about. They were forced to travel far from home in Nazareth, all the way to Bethlehem to participate in a census ordered by the occupying forces ...while Mary was nine months pregnant. There was no housing available, making them homeless. Then the baby came, with no crib, only a feeding trough/manger used by the livestock who lived in that smelly cave in which this Homeless Family was sheltering.

That is the situation into which *Eternal HOPE* was born. Love's Pure Light was born that Holy Night. Mary and Joseph could have been filled with discouragement except for the sheer joy they saw in the Christ Child, and their fidelity to God's plan.

This is our path: to remain faithful to Christ who is fully present in our lives and our world.

This year, let Love's Pure Light shine in you and through you. Call to Him, put your hope in Him... JESUS, my Savior!

School pick up is 12:30-1:30 PM each day. Please do not park in the middle of the back section so school parents can form carline.



ONLINE GIVING IN 3 EASY STEPS



If you are already using online giving skip step 1 and 2. (If you forgot your user ID or password click the forgot button and a new password will be emailed to you.)

STEP 1 - REGISTER

- From <u>www.ollparish.com</u>
- Click "Giving" in top right navigation bar
- Click on "Give Now:
- Click on **CREATE A NEW ACCOUNT.**
- Fill in the information boxes that contain a red asterisk. Make sure to write down your User ID and Password.
- Submit. You will receive an email to confirm your information.

STEP 2 – SET UP METHOD

- Now log into your account, click on **MY PAYMENT METHOD**.
- You will need to ADD NEW BANK ACCOUNT (if using your checking account) OR ADD NEW CREDIT CARD (if using your credit card).
- Provide all the information requested. Then click **SUBMIT**.

STEP 3 – SET UP DONATION

- **OPTIONS**: You can choose multiple funds (RE, Maintenance, SVdP)
- Return to MANAGE MY ACCOUNT and choose GIVE A NEW GIFT.
- Choose **OFFERTORY** (fund), then select gift type **RECURRING**.
- Select payment and frequency and start date.
- Select the account (check or credit card), then enter amount and frequency.
- Click **NEXT** (bottom of page)
- In the CONFIRM MY GIFTS window, review the details to insure everything is correct. Click SUBMIT.
