The Baptism of the Lord

The Power of Baptism

Today the Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Baptism of Our Lord. This brings to an end the season of Christmas and recalls Our Lord's second manifestation or "epiphany" which occurred on the occasion of His baptism in the Jordan.

We don't usually think of the waters of Baptism as quenching "thirst" in the same way we need water on a hot day, or after strenuous work or exercise. Yet, this precious water renews our lives in the most vital way and helps us carry on as disciples. As we hear in the words of Isaiah: *"All you who are thirsty, come to the water!"* (Isaiah 55:1).

I was thinking about the power of Baptism as I reflected on the tumultuous events of the past year and the troubled waters of our current world situation. I am thirsting for the planet to be healed of pandemic and I am parched for civil discourse. Even as the Oregon rains continue in these winter days, I remember too well the smoke and haze of forest fires and racial unrest across the nation. But I place my trust in the Lord for: *"God indeed is my savior; I am confident and unafraid"* (Isaiah 12:2).

As Jesus comes to the Jordan to be baptized, one of the first elements of creation fashioned by the Father through the

Son, is now re-created through the Incarnate Son. Jesus, the Incarnate Word, stands in the waters of the earth which was created through Him. It is an incredible scene: The Spirit hovering like a dove over Jesus, and a voice from heaven declaring: *"You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased"* (Mark 1:11).

As we hear these words – you are my beloved – may we take strength for the new year that God's love continues to transform and recreate the world *and each one of us* through Christ. May our thirst for healing, peace and restoration be refreshed by our awareness that God's love continues to surround us, even in darkest times.

At Mass this weekend, whether in person or online, we will be reminded of our own baptism – perhaps taking place in recent years or many years ago as infants. In that sacramental moment we were invited to follow Jesus.

Will we allow His will to "be done in me" as our Blessed Mother declared to the Angel Gabriel? As we conclude this

Christmas season, we are challenged to live our baptism and to grow deeper in our commitment to love and serve the Lord. Through, with and in Christ, may we be the water that quenches thirst for those in need.

ONLINE GIVING IN 3 EASY STEPS

If you are already using online giving skip step 1 and 2. (if you forgot your user ID or password click the forgot button and a new password will be emailed to you)

STEP 1 - REGISTER

- From OLL website www.ollparish.com
- Click "Giving" in top right navigation bar
- Click on "Give Now:
- Click on **CREATE A NEW ACCOUNT**.
- Fill in the information boxes that contain a red asterisk. Make sure to write down your User ID and Password (put in a secure and safe place.)
- **Submit. You will receive an email to confirm your information.**



STEP 2 – SET UP PAYMENT METHOD

- Now log into your account, click on **MY PAYMENT METHOD**.
- You will need to **ADD NEW BANK ACCOUNT** (if using your checking account) OR **ADD NEW CREDIT CARD** (if using your credit card).
- Provide all the information requested. Then click **SUBMIT**.

STEP 3 – SET UP DONATION

OPTIONS: You can choose multiple funds (RE, Building Maintenance, SVdP)

- Now return to **MANAGE MY ACCOUNT** and choose **GIVE A NEW GIFT**.
- Choose **OFFERTORY** (fund), then select gift type **RECURRING**.
- Select payment and frequency and start date.
- Select the account (check or credit card), then enter amount and frequency.
- Click **NEXT** (at the bottom of the page)
- In the **CONFIRM MY GIFTS** window, review the details to insure all is correct. Click **SUBMIT**.

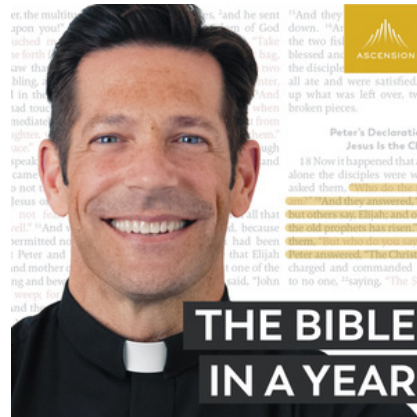

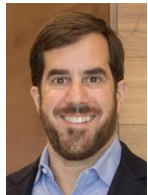
