Return to in-person learning, digital open house, and online auction.

Even in the midst of a pandemic, Our Lady of the Lake School has been busy a place.

Since September, OLL School has had kindergarten-third grade in-person learning in small, socially distanced cohorts. This past month on January 11, OLL School added fourth and fifth grades to in-person instruction and are excited to bring back sixth, seventh, and eighth grades in February.

In order to safely bring back all grades for in-person learning, OLL School has faithfully implemented physical distancing, the use of face coverings, increased hand hygiene, increased cleaning and disinfecting of facilities, and maximized the airflow and ventilation through a state-of-the-art ultraviolet air purifier. We are very proud of the ways we have supported the health and safety of students, staff, and families each day.

Once all kindergarten-eighth grades are back on campus, OLL School will continue to serve those students and families digitally who are unable to attend in-person learning due to documented health diagnoses.

The OLL Parish community can continue to support the OLL School in their endeavor to remain safely open for in-person learning by continuing to wear masks and social distance. Part of this social distancing means continuing to contact the parish office by phone or email and not stopping by the parish center without an appointment.



As a reminder, carline for student pick up begins at 12:30 PM and ends at 1:30 PM. Please do not park in the middle of the back section of the parking lot so children can safely be picked up by parents.

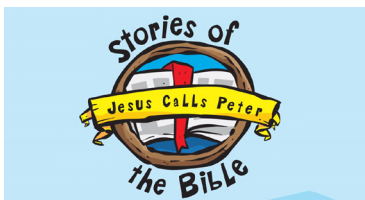

Word of God Sunday

Pope Francis has decreed the Third Sunday of Ordinary Time each year to be **Word of God Sunday**. The second celebration of this annual focus will be this Sunday, January 24, 2021. We invite you to consider ways to honor the Bible in your homes and hearts.

In his decree, "*Aperuit Illis*," the Holy Father said, "He opened their minds to understand the Scriptures" (Lk 24:45). This was one of the final acts of the risen Lord before his Ascension. Jesus appeared to the assembled disciples, broke bread with them and opened their minds to the understanding of the sacred Scriptures.

The relationship between the Risen Lord, the community of believers and sacred Scripture is essential to our identity as Christians. Without the Lord who opens our minds to His Word, it is impossible to understand the Scriptures in depth. Yet the contrary is equally true: without the Scriptures, the events of the mission of Jesus and of his Church in this world would remain incomprehensible."

The Holy Father continues, "Regular reading of sacred Scripture and the celebration of the Eucharist make it possible for us to see ourselves as part of one another. As Christians, we are a single people, making our pilgrim way through history, sustained by the Lord, present in our midst, who speaks to us and nourishes us."

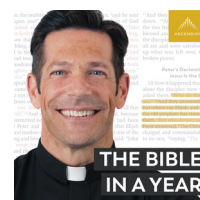
St Vincent de Paul Christmas Food Box — Thank You

Lovejoy Surgicenter CLOSED!

On January 16, Oregon's largest abortion provider, Lovejoy Surgicenter CLOSED. Cancellation of appointments and turnover of staff had been high. The building is outdated and badly ventilated and they can no longer sustain their business.

Lovejoy Surgicenter has been the major provider of abortion in Oregon doing abortions through 24 weeks.

Over 50 years, thousands of prayer warriors have faithfully stood vigil outside this terrible facility. They have offered help to the women who entered the facility and the people who worked there.

Rejoice with us for this major victory for the unborn, for mothers, fathers, grandparents....so many impacted by this particular facility which has been at the forefront of this battle since before Roe vs. Wade.

The battle is not over. An abortionist from Seattle hopes to purchase Lovejoy's business interests and open in downtown Portland. Please pray that this late-term abortionist will not be successful in expanding his business to Portland.

They operate as a self-referring "outreach service" intended to fill in the gaps of other providers. The all-volunteer staff responds to calls for assistance left on their 24/7 voice mail.
