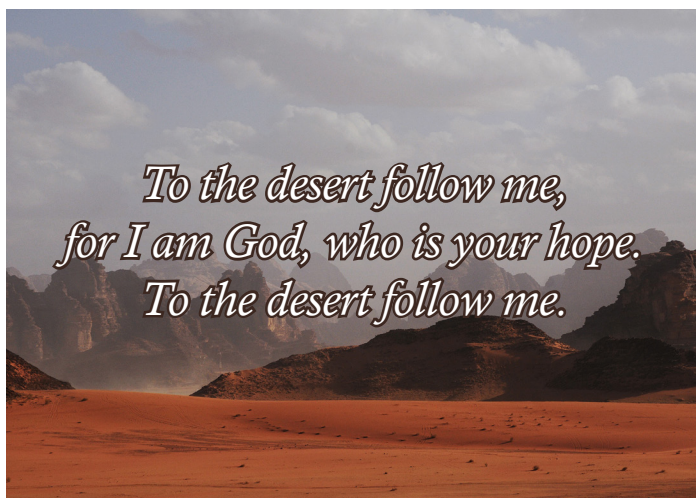

## OUR LADY OF THE LAKE CATHOLIC CHURCH

### Our Lenten Theme: *To the Desert Follow Me*



Our Lenten Entrance song will remind us each weekend that Lent is a time to place our full trust and hope – all of ourselves – in God alone. Jesus spent forty days in the desert to prepare for his ministry on earth. There he prayed and fasted and was given strength and perseverance through relationship with his Father to carry out God's will and plan for salvation. Lent invites us to let go of our deeply held assurances in possessions, power and principle as we place our trust in God.

Little did we know that the recent ice storm would add more hardship to this pandemic year, moving us to new levels of patience and tenacity. We might be asking, "how much more must we give up, Lord?" Hopefully, these continuing trials can help us develop greater generosity and understanding of those in need. Lent allows us to take that spiritual growth – our call to discipleship – to the next level.

In his Lenten letter, Fr. John suggests that, *"During this coming Lent we need to be even more committed to authentic discipleship in this changing world. I don't want to go back to the way things were pre-pandemic. Rather, I want to be part of creating something better for a post-pandemic world: greater faith, greater strength, greater love."*

#### Return to Me with All Your Heart

The 40 days of Lent lead us to the Sacred Triduum of Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Easter Vigil on Saturday, April 3. Easter Sunday is April 4. How will you and your family enter into this Holy Season with acts of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving so as to be: more connected with Jesus, more self-disciplined, and more generous?

#### Daily Mass, Adoration, and Stations of the Cross

Lent is a great opportunity to make it to daily Mass at 8:30 am or 6:00 PM on Tuesdays through Thursdays. Our church is open after Mass until 4 PM every day for adoration of the blessed sacrament present in the tabernacle, and we will have Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament all day on Friday, March 5.

We will offer **Stations of the Cross** in Church and livestreamed on Fridays, February 19 through March 26. We'll be using a new simple, sign-in system to make it easier to register family and household members to attend together.

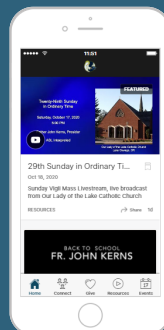

## ONLINE GIVING IN 3 EASY STEPS

If you are already using online giving skip step 1 and 2. (if you forgot your user ID or password click the forgot button and a new password will be emailed to you)

### STEP 1 - REGISTER

- From OLL website [www.ollparish.com](http://www.ollparish.com)
- Click **"Giving"** in top right navigation bar
- Click on **"Give Now"**:
- Click on **CREATE A NEW ACCOUNT**.
- Fill in the information boxes that contain a red asterisk. Make sure to write down your User ID and Password (put in a secure and safe place.)
- **Submit.** You will receive an email to confirm your information.



### STEP 2 – SET UP PAYMENT METHOD

- Now log into your account, click on **MY PAYMENT METHOD**.
- You will need to **ADD NEW BANK ACCOUNT** (if using your checking account) OR **ADD NEW CREDIT CARD** (if using your credit card).
- Provide all the information requested. Then click **SUBMIT**.

### STEP 3 – SET UP DONATION

**OPTIONS:** You can choose multiple funds (RE, Building Maintenance, SVdP)

- Now return to **MANAGE MY ACCOUNT** and choose **GIVE A NEW GIFT**.
- Choose **OFFERTORY** (fund), then select gift type **RECURRING**.
- Select payment and frequency and start date.
- Select the account (check or credit card), then enter amount and frequency.
- Click **NEXT** (at the bottom of the page)
- In the **CONFIRM MY GIFTS** window, review the details to insure all is correct. Click **SUBMIT**.

## Our Lenten Theme *continued*

### Sacrament of Reconciliation (Confessions)

Individual Confession is available every Saturday from 9:30 until 10:30 am in the Church following morning Mass. Additional times for confession include Sundays, from 10:20 until 11:00 am between Masses, and Wednesdays February 24-March 24 at 7:00 PM following evening Mass. Due to COVID we are unable to offer our Lenten Reconciliation services with multiple confessors available.

### Almsgiving

Once again, we are invited help our brothers and sisters in need through the charitable efforts of our St. Vincent de Paul Food Bank and Knights of Columbus **40 Cans for Lent** drive. You can drop off non-perishable food items at the barrels in church entrances or on Sunday mornings during the **Mercy Teams Sack Lunch Meals of Mercy** weekly collections. ### INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY AT OUR LADY OF THE LAKE

*Policy adjusted for COVID-19 pandemic.*

**Weekdays:** Parish programs follow the morning snow closure and bad weather directions of the Lake Oswego School District. When the Lake Oswego schools are closed, parish programs are also closed.

**Weekends or evenings:** If there is a sudden change in the weather during the day, or the program meets in the evening or on a weekend, the Program Director or group organizer of the respective programs will make the decision as to the closure based upon consideration of the different areas surrounding OLL. The Program Director will also initiate the process of notifying people. If you are not sure if a program is cancelled, please email your program director or call the office at 503-636-7687 for closure information.
