Fourth Sunday of Lent

Consecration to St. Joseph

Pope Pius IX declared St. Joseph, the patron of the Universal Church on December 8, 1870. With the Apostolic letter "*Patris Corde*" (With a Father's Heart), Pope Francis recalls the 150th anniversary of the declaration of Saint Joseph as Patron of the Universal Church. To mark the occasion, the Holy Father has proclaimed a "Year of St. Joseph" from 8 December 2020 to 8 December 2021.

In his Apostolic letter, Pope Francis reflected on the fatherly qualities of St. Joseph, describing him as beloved, tender, loving, obedient, accepting, working and "creatively courageous". In his obedience to God's will, he protected Mary and Jesus, and taught his Son to "do the will of the Father." Called by God to serve the mission of Jesus, he cooperated in the great mystery of Redemption. *Patris Corde* highlights that the carpenter of Nazareth was able to turn a problem into possibility by trusting in divine providence. Christians can discover in St. Joseph, an intercessor, a support and, a guide in times of trouble.

In the Archdiocese of Portland, the pastors are encouraged to organize special prayers and devotions, dedicated to the foster father of Jesus,

to mark the "Year of St. Joseph." People are invited to consecrate themselves to St. Joseph.

What does it mean to consecrate yourself to St. Joseph?

Basically, consecration means to entrust yourself entirely to his paternal care so that he can help you acquire his virtues and become holy. The person who consecrates himself to St. Joseph wants to be as close as possible to his spiritual father. St. Joseph, in turn, will give those consecrated to him his undivided attention, protection and guidance.

How Is consecration to St. Joseph done and what is the method?

Consecration to St. Joseph is a comprehensive program of preparation and consecration to St. Joseph for individuals, families, parishes, and dioceses. It is a 33-day preparation and consecration. On each day of the 33-day preparation (Day 1 and Day 2 are the only exception), a short exposition on one of the invocations in the Litany of St. Joseph is presented (in Part I), followed by a reading on St. Joseph (a section of Part II), concluding with the recitation of the Litany of



St. Joseph (found in Part III). The 33-day preparation requires about 20 to 30 minutes a day. If you miss a day, just make it up and continue your preparation.

It is recommended to choose a day to begin preparation that will coincide with a liturgical feast of St. Joseph. The 33-day program begins in OLL Parish on March 30 and ends on May 1, the Feast of St. Joseph the Worker. It can be undertaken on your own or in a group.

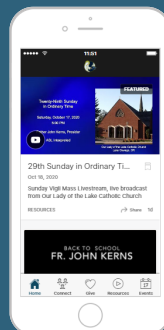

ONLINE GIVING IN 3 EASY STEPS

If you are already using online giving skip step 1 and 2. (if you forgot your user ID or password click the forgot button and a new password will be emailed to you)

STEP 1 - REGISTER

- From OLL website www.ollparish.com
- Click **"Giving"** in top right navigation bar
- Click on **"Give Online via My Own Giving"**
- Click on **CREATE A NEW ACCOUNT.**
- Fill in the information boxes that contain a red asterisk. Make sure to write down your User ID and Password (put in a secure and safe place.)
- **Submit.** You will receive an email to confirm your information.



STEP 2 - SET UP PAYMENT METHOD

- Now log into your account, click on **MY PAYMENT METHOD.**
- You will need to **ADD NEW BANK ACCOUNT** (if using your checking account) OR **ADD NEW CREDIT CARD** (if using your credit card).
- Provide all the information requested. Then click **SUBMIT.**

STEP 3 - SET UP DONATION

OPTIONS: You can choose multiple funds (RE, Building Maintenance, SVdP)

- Now return to **MANAGE MY ACCOUNT** and choose **GIVE A NEW GIFT.**
- Choose **OFFERTORY** (fund), then select gift type **RECURRING.**
- Select payment and frequency and start date.
- Select the account (check or credit card), then enter amount and frequency.
- Click **NEXT** (at the bottom of the page)
- In the **CONFIRM MY GIFTS** window, review the details to insure all is correct. Click **SUBMIT.**

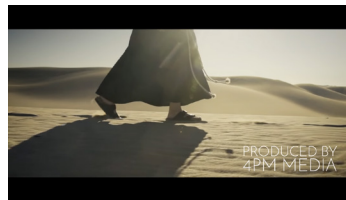
