Responding to Christ in Mission

The disciples rejoiced when they saw the Lord. Jesus said to them again, "Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I send you." And when he had said this, he breathed on them and said, "Receive the Holy Spirit."

~ John 20:20-22 ~

On Pentecost we hear St. John's account of Jesus' appearance to the disciples and sending them forth with the gift of the Holy Spirit. Jesus sends them with the message of peace, and of their relationship with the Father through his union with the Father. Christ's message of peace reminds us of the same greeting given by the angels to the shepherds at Jesus' birth. The world needs this hope more than ever.

In last weekend's homily, Fr. John implored us to live our lives as witnesses of God's salvation and freedom gained for us through Jesus' suffering, death and resurrection. Every Christian has that capacity to give witness - regardless of our age - children, youth, and adults - to bring that Good News to the world. Each of us has a "circle of influence"

to reach out to friends, family and those we encounter in our daily lives at school, work and social interactions. At Communion, we sang, "Send us out to be your hands and feet!"

The Mission of God Has a Church

On this Pentecost, though we are continuously aware of the difficulties our world is experiencing during this pandemic, we look forward to new opportunities to take Christ's message of salvation to the ends of the earth. We

> usually hear that command as: The Church has a mission. Well and good. However, it may be more instructive to understand that God's Mission has a Church! Both individually and collectively, we are entrusted to take up the work of bringing God's mission to those we meet. This is not just the task of priests and parish staff but of every baptized Christian. Our capacity as Church to make a difference depends on every Christian giving their gifts – breathed on us by the Holy Spirit.

Liturgy, Music, and Prayer

Helping in Ministry at Mass

Throughout the pandemic we have had to adjust our approach and need for various liturgical ministers. Initially, we were only livestreaming Mass without an assembly – or ministers to assist as ushers, altar servers, and Eucharistic ministers. Over the past few months as restrictions on gathering have changed, we have welcomed back the help of many parishioners in these roles. We are very grateful for their willingness to serve!

In coming weeks, as capacities continue to change, we will begin to need even more assistance. We understand that many people who previously served may still be unable to help due to COVID related issues, but we encourage every parishioner to ask how he or she could contribute to the various liturgical ministries. SIMPLY PUT: if more individuals are involved, the responsibility would be more equally shared. How can you help?

Ushers.

We have the greatest need for ushers, door monitors and greeters especially at all weekend Masses. This role is primarily about providing a spirit of hospitality – especially to many parishioners returning to Mass for the first time in over a year. Consider serving once a month or alternating weeks with another person. That allows you to simply attend Mass on other occasions.

Eucharistic Ministers.

Many people consider themselves "unworthy" to serve in this special ministry. But remember Jesus' response to Peter when he refused to let him wash his feet. We are all unworthy except for our salvation in Christ. You will never have a greater appreciation for the Holy Eucharist than in service to others.

Altar Servers.

Currently, we are not scheduling altar servers for Mass but are making plans to return to a regular schedule of altar servers over the summer months. If you have previously served or would like to be trained to serve, please contact tomt@ollparish.com and we will be in touch with further information.

Scheduling and Training.

Our online Ministry Scheduler makes it very convenient to accept an assignment or ask for a substitute if your schedule changes. It can also set up particular service times for certain Masses. We offer training for ALL ministries or you can "shadow" a current minister to see if it is a good fit for you.
