Relationship in the Most Holy Trinity

"All power in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age."

 \sim Matthew 28:18-20 \sim

We are baptized into our Catholic faith with these words – *in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit* – which Jesus speaks at the conclusion of the Gospel according to St. Matthew. With these instructions, Jesus sends the eleven out to make disciples throughout the world. It is amazing that from its earliest moments the Church has used this same liturgical formula to name and claim each one of us in the name of the Most Holy Trinity.

How do we best understand the Holy Trinity? If God is three persons, then the very essence of God is a *relationship* of Lover, Beloved, and the Spirit of Love which emanates from that

Divine Presence. Therefore, the very

essence of our belief in God is grounded in a relationship with God in three persons. Most of us can imagine and develop a relationship with God the Father, following Jesus' own words of that primary relationship while he was with us on earth. But how do we imagine and have relationship with the Holy Spirit?

St. Paul provides a path to understanding the role of the Spirit in today's passage from his letter to the Romans: "You received a Spirit of adoption, through whom we cry, 'Abba, Father!' The Spirit himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God, and if children, then heirs, heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ" (Romans 8:15-17). By our baptism then we are immersed into relationship with God and participate in God's mission here on earth.

The Mission of God Has a Church

We each have work to do and have been given spiritual gifts in abundance to accomplish our part. Last weekend, Fr. John called on each of us to reflect and consider how we are being called in this current and unique moment of history to take our rightful place in the Mission of God in one of four areas of parish life – Lifelong Faith Formation, Parish Liturgical Life, Social Outreach, and Pastoral Care.

What effort are you being called to

consider or renew? We do these things in relationship with the Most Holy Trinity, knowing and counting on Jesus' promise: "*I am with you always, until the end of the age.*"

- Now log into your account, click on **MY PAYMENT METHOD**.
- You will need to ADD NEW BANK ACCOUNT (if using your checking account) OR ADD NEW CREDIT CARD (if using your credit card).
- Provide all the information requested. Then click **SUBMIT**.

STEP 3 – SET UP DONATION

OPTIONS: You can choose multiple funds (RE, Building Maintenance, SVdP) • Now return to **MANAGE MY ACCOUNT** and choose **GIVE A NEW GIFT**.

- Choose **OFFERTORY** (fund), then select gift type **RECURRING**.
- Select payment and frequency and start date.
- Select the account (check or credit card), then enter amount and frequency.
- Click **NEXT** (at the bottom of the page)
- In the **CONFIRM MY GIFTS** window, review the details to insure all is correct. Click **SUBMIT**.



Liturgy, Music, and Prayer

Helping in Ministry at Mass

Throughout the pandemic we have had to adjust our approach and need for various liturgical ministers. Initially, we were only livestreaming Mass without an assembly – or ministers to assist as ushers, altar servers, and Eucharistic ministers. Over the past few months as restrictions on gathering have changed, we have welcomed back the help of many parishioners in these roles. We are very grateful for their willingness to serve!

In coming weeks, as capacities continue to change, we will begin to need even more assistance. We understand that many people who previously served may still be unable to help due to COVID related issues, but we encourage every parishioner to ask how he or she could contribute to the various liturgical ministries. SIMPLY PUT: if more individuals are involved, the responsibility would be more equally shared. How can you help?

Ushers.

We have the greatest need for ushers, door monitors and greeters especially at all weekend Masses. This role is primarily about providing a spirit of hospitality – especially to many parishioners returning to Mass for the first time in over a year. Consider serving once a month or alternating weeks with another person. That allows you to simply attend Mass on other occasions.

Eucharistic Ministers.

Many people consider themselves "unworthy" to serve in this special ministry. But remember Jesus' response to Peter when he refused to let him wash his feet. We are all unworthy except for our salvation in Christ. You will never have a greater appreciation for the Holy Eucharist than in service to others.

Altar Servers.

Currently, we are not scheduling altar servers for Mass but are making plans to return to a regular schedule of altar servers over the summer months. If you have previously served or would like to be trained to serve, please contact tomt@ ollparish.com and we will be in touch with further information.

Scheduling and Training.

Our online Ministry Scheduler makes it very convenient to accept an assignment or ask for a substitute if your schedule changes. It can also set up particular service times for certain Masses. We offer training for ALL ministries or you can "shadow" a current minister to see if it is a good fit for you.


