My dear OLL parishioners:

One of the hardest losses for me during this pandemic was being separated from you. Now, each time I see a parishioner, my heart skips a beat.

A few weeks ago I preached *The Kerygma*, that is, *The Good News*: God has a plan for the world. He wants the message of salvation through his Son Jesus Christ to reach the ears of every human person, and to spiritually transform every soul. This is always God's plan, even during a pandemic. How does he accomplish that plan? Through all of us, through our service and prayer, and through our ministries made possible by your financial support of our parish.

Father Roger Schroeder (of the Catholic Theological Union of Chicago) once wrote, *The church doesn't have a mission, but the mission of God has a church*. In other words, rather than ask how we want to plan our activities for our parish, we should ask God what his plan is for our world, and then how our parish can help make that happen.

ONLINE GIVING IN 3 EASY STEPS

If you are already using online giving skip step 1 and 2. (if you forgot your user ID or password click the forgot button and a new password will be emailed to you)

STEP 1 - REGISTER

- From OLL website www.ollparish.com
- Click **"Giving"** in top right navigation bar
- Click on **"Give Online via My Own Giving"**
- Click on **CREATE A NEW ACCOUNT**.
- Fill in the information boxes that contain a red asterisk. Make sure to write down your User ID and Password (put in a secure and safe place.)
- **Submit. You will receive an email to confirm your information.**



STEP 2 – SET UP PAYMENT METHOD

- Now log into your account, click on **MY PAYMENT METHOD**.
- You will need to **ADD NEW BANK ACCOUNT** (if using your checking account) OR **ADD NEW CREDIT CARD** (if using your credit card).
- Provide all the information requested. Then click **SUBMIT**.

STEP 3 – SET UP DONATION

OPTIONS: You can choose multiple funds (RE, Building Maintenance, SVdP)

- Now return to **MANAGE MY ACCOUNT** and choose **GIVE A NEW GIFT**.
- Choose **OFFERTORY** (fund), then select gift type **RECURRING**.
- Select payment and frequency and start date.
- Select the account (check or credit card), then enter amount and frequency.
- Click **NEXT** (at the bottom of the page)
- In the **CONFIRM MY GIFTS** window, review the details to insure all is correct. Click **SUBMIT**.

Corpus Christi: Communion and the Body of Christ continued

On Pentecost I focused on our gifts of service. Today I'd like to focus on our monetary gifts. Without our normal Sunday collections, our income has definitely dipped. We have hovered around \$100,000 behind budgeted income. Still, I was impressed at how quickly so many of you shifted to on-line giving so that our shortfall wasn't worse. Many shifted to mailing their gift, and some parishioners stopped by the church to pray and hand deliver their regular gift into our secure donation slot in the narthex. What a great commitment!

Regarding costs, we had fewer in-person programs this year (less expense). Many of those program costs were offset by fees we did not collect, so that was a wash. But, as you can imagine, our janitorial bill went up dramatically due to extra COVID cleanings. We tallied \$71,965 to date of all COVID related costs which put us over budgeted expenses. (See more information on page 7.)

In the Psalm for Corpus Christi Sunday we pray, *How can I make a return to the Lord for all the good he has done for me?* (Psalm 116:12). To be a steward means to recognize that everything I have is a gift from God that has been placed in my care for the good of my household and for others. Therefore, in a spirit of gratitude I am called to make a commitment to give back to God – for the sake of God's mission – a portion (percentage) of what I have received. A proportionate gift means I may either decrease or increase my contribution, depending on if my financial situation has worsened or improved. What I ask of you, I do myself.

Therefore, I ask you, please consider what you will give to our parish this year and pray for the guidance of the Holy Spirit. Consider electronic giving, or whatever mode makes the most sense to you. It is truly an act of faith. And thank you for your commitment to Our Lady of the Lake Catholic Church. May God bless you and your loved ones.



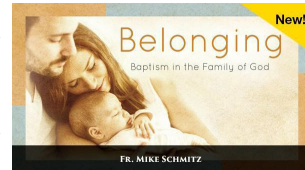

CORPUS CHRISTI: COMMUNION IN THE BODY OF CHRIST

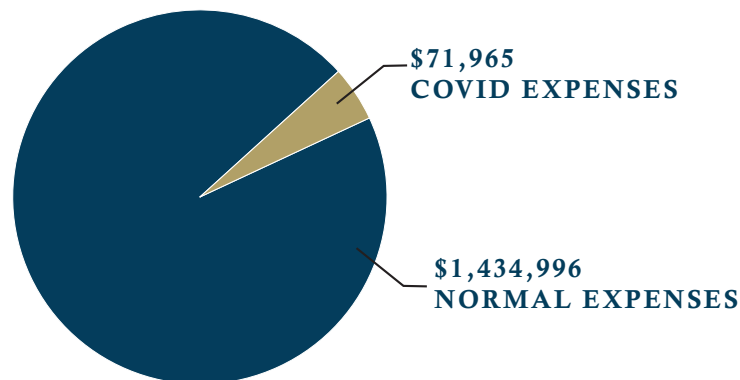
How shall I make a return to the Lord, for all the good God has done for me?

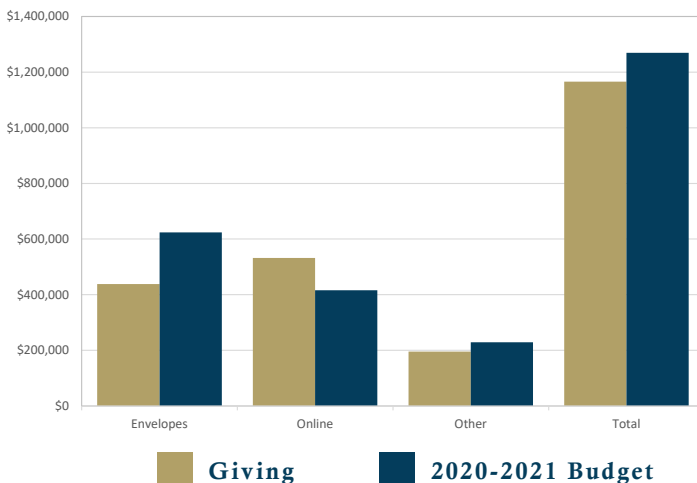
The Holy Eucharist, the sacred Body and Blood of Christ, is the most precious gift we have been given and our communion in the Body of Christ, here and forever. Our response to God's saving action requires us to ask: *how can I support God's mission given to the Church to share this good news, here and now?* On Pentecost, we reflected how we can take up or renew our giving of time and talent in one of the four areas of parish life. On this Solemnity of Corpus Christi, we consider how we might support God's mission through our financial contributions.

As we conclude our fiscal year on June 30th and budget for the coming year and a return of programs and services, we are grateful for your continued financial support of Our Lady of the Lake parish during the pandemic. You have been so faithful in giving, especially by transitioning to online giving – now 55% of Total Giving – which helps us budget for expenses. However, COVID increased our costs for cleaning and equipment by \$71,965 to date. Combined with a loss of weekly in-person and envelope offerings, we are behind budget by \$103,000 through April and will need to cover that shortfall. Next year's budget anticipates a further increase in online giving as well as continued COVID related costs. Below are three graphs that show: COVID-related extra costs, where we stand in our current budget, and comparison for next fiscal year (July 2021-June 2022).

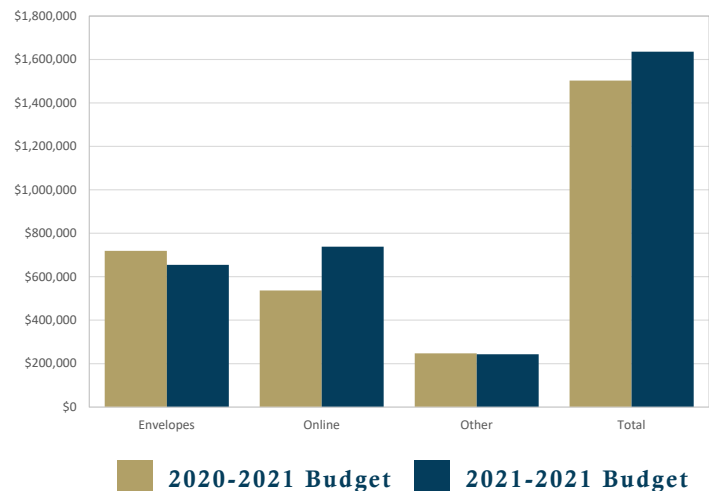
