ONLINE GIVING IN 3 EASY STEPS

STEP 1 - REGISTER

- From OLL website <u>www.ollparish.com</u>
- Click "Giving" in top right navigation bar
- Click on "Give Online via My Own Giving"
- Click on CREATE A NEW ACCOUNT.
- Online Giving
- Fill in the information boxes that contain a red asterisk. Make sure to write down your User ID and Password (put in a secure and safe place.)
- Submit. You will receive an email to confirm your information.

STEP 2 – SET UP PAYMENT METHOD

- Now log into your account, click on **MY PAYMENT METHOD**.
- You will need to ADD NEW BANK ACCOUNT (if using your checking account) OR ADD NEW CREDIT CARD (if using your credit card).
- Provide all the information requested. Then click **SUBMIT**.

STEP 3 – SET UP DONATION

OPTIONS: You can choose multiple funds (RE, Building Maintenance, SVdP) • Now return to **MANAGE MY ACCOUNT** and choose **GIVE A NEW GIFT**.

- Choose **OFFERTORY** (fund), then select gift type **RECURRING**.
- Select payment and frequency and start date.
- Select the account (check or credit card), then enter amount and frequency.
- Click **NEXT** (at the bottom of the page)
- In the **CONFIRM MY GIFTS** window, review the details to insure all is correct. Click **SUBMIT**.

Liturgy Updates for Summer

NO Registration Needed. Thank you for your patience! Beginning this weekend, you no longer need to register to attend Mass on Sundays or weekdays. We anticipate having enough room in the church to accommodate all who wish to attend Mass. We will maintain a dedicated area for social distancing and masks required in the west transept and first several pews. In the rest of the church you may sit where you please and masks are optional.

Seating will be on a first-come basis, so arriving early will be important.

All Church Entrances OPEN. All church entrances will now be open for daily and weekend Masses. Feel free to use the elevator entrance to the church again.

Sunday Mass Schedule. Beginning Sunday, June 20 we are adjusting the time of the later Sunday Mass to begin one half hour earlier at **11:00 AM** since we currently do not have faith formation in between the morning Masses.

Weekday Mass Schedule Beginning Monday, June 21 we are also moving the Wednesday and Thursday 6:00 PM Mass back to 6:30 AM but keeping the Tuesday 6:00 PM Mass. Mass will also be at 8:30 AM Monday through Saturday.

Ushers. We have a great need for ushers at all weekend Masses. This role is provides a spirit of hospitality – especially to many parishioners returning to Mass for the first time in over a year. Consider serving once a month or alternating weeks with another person. That allows you to simply attend Mass on other occasions.

Eucharistic Ministers. Please consider helping in this special ministry. Many people consider themselves "unworthy" to serve but remember Jesus' response to Peter when he refused to let him wash his feet. We are all unworthy except for our salvation in Christ. You will never have a greater appreciation for the Holy Eucharist than in service to others.

Altar Servers. We are making plans to return to a regular schedule of altar servers. If you have previously served or would like to be trained to serve, please contact tomt@ollparish.com and we will be in touch with further information.

Scheduling and Training. Our online Ministry Scheduler makes it very convenient to accept an assignment or ask for a substitute if your schedule changes. It can also set up particular service times for certain Masses. We offer training for ALL ministries or you can "shadow" a current minister to see if it is a good fit for you.


