Your Faith Has Saved You

These past eighteen months have given us significant opportunities to ponder death and our own mortality as we have witnessed the pandemic take millions of lives and ravage culture as we knew it. Now, as we take off our masks and rediscover the joys of moving about more freely, our liturgy this week provides time and perspective on life, death, and faith in God's providence and plan for us.

God did not make death;
nor does he rejoice in the destruction of the living.
For he fashioned all things that they might have being;
and the creatures of the world are wholesome.
For God formed man to be imperishable;
the image of his own nature he made him.

Wisdom 1:13-14; 2:23

God Did Not Make Death

In this weekend's first reading from the Wisdom of Solomon, written about 50 years before Christ and at another time of great suffering and oppression in the lives of the community, the author states Israel's emerging belief in the resurrection – God's loving plan for us all from the beginning. As Jesus was to say, *God is a God not of the dead but of the living* (Mark 12:27). We are each created

in the image of God, a reflection of God's own life. How does our faith in that promise of eternal life affect our worldview and also are daily approach to living?

The Miracle of Life

In this week's Gospel, Jesus performs two miracles: healing a woman with a severe hemorrhage and raising the daughter of Jairus back to life. These powerful moments in Jesus' early ministry provide clear focus on his prime message as he declares to the woman, "Your faith has saved you" and to Jairus, "Do not be afraid; just have faith." The Christ invites us to His worldview – faith in God's life eternal.

Our profound faith in the resurrection is being tested here in our parish community as we have twelve funerals pending in the next number of weeks. I invite your prayers for these individuals and their families, some whom have endured great suffering in this life, and several whose deaths occurred during the pandemic whose families are now finally able to gather to honor their loved ones. May they rest in peace and may our faith in the promise of eternal life be strengthened.



STEP 1 - REGISTER

STEP 2 – SET UP PAYMENT METHOD

- Now log into your account, click on MY PAYMENT METHOD.
- You will need to ADD NEW BANK ACCOUNT (if using your checking account)
 OR ADD NEW CREDIT CARD (if using your credit card).
- Provide all the information requested. Then click **SUBMIT**.

STEP 3 – SET UP DONATION

OPTIONS: You can choose multiple funds (RE, Building Maintenance, SVdP)

- Now return to MANAGE MY ACCOUNT and choose GIVE A NEW GIFT.
- Choose **OFFERTORY** (fund), then select gift type **RECURRING**.
- Select payment and frequency and start date.
- Select the account (check or credit card), then enter amount and frequency.
- Click **NEXT** (at the bottom of the page)
- In the CONFIRM MY GIFTS window, review the details to insure all is correct.



ACTS Retreats are Back! Arianne's Story of Attending ACTS



Arianne Cakarnis attended the women's ACTS retreat in November, 2018. Arianne has been a parishioner of OLL for over a decade and been involved in a variety of ministries in the parish and also at the school. A lifelong Catholic, she grew up in St. Rose parish, attended Central Catholic High School and the University of Notre Dame. Arianne loves to travel with her family and is an avid consumer of Catholic autobiographies (a few favorites include *The Shed that Fed a Million Children, Left to Tell, Subverted, Something Other than God, and From Fire by Water*).

Arianne and her husband Dave's two boys, Quinn and Briggs, attend Our Lady of the Lake School. As a busy mom, the time commitment of the retreat seemed like a "big ask." While the length of the retreat initially seemed like a hurdle, Arianne said her participation in the retreat has proven to be a huge blessing in her life and well worth the efforts it took to be away from home for a couple of days.

In reflecting back on her retreat, Arianne remembers the powerful experience of hearing about the faith journeys of the women that served as retreat leaders. In addition, the small group discussions fostered great conversations and camaraderie with other women in our parish. Arianne's connections within our church community expanded as a result of her attending the retreat. "By sharing this intense time with other parishioners, you develop a bond that would be very rare to experience in day-to-day interactions. The more connected we are to our church community, the more vibrant our parish is for all others who encounter it." Arianne reflected on the fact that the retreat encounter will never leave her, and it's something she can always revisit. Her advice to anyone considering attending an ACTS retreat is to not let the length of the retreat deter you. The benefits of participation will most likely have a lasting impact on your faith. She suggests offering up any obstacles to participating and "just say yes to the great gift that lies before you."
