## The Return of Our Music Ministries

This month, after eighteen months absence during the pandemic, our music ministries have returned to their normally scheduled Mass assignments. We are grateful for your patience and understanding during this time of limited ability to gather instruments and voices.

During these many months, we have supported the livestream broadcasts with a minimal trio of Agnes Zueger on piano and vocals, Serha Kwak on violin, and me, Tom Tomaszek, leading as cantor and on guitar. In recent months Nan Haemer, cantor, and Cherise da Cunha on piano, have added their expertise to our team.

We are blessed with an assembly who sing and participate in the sung responses at Mass. Our music ministries serve to lead, support, and enhance your participation.

**Saturday, 5:00 PM**. Our choir and cantors will once again lead the music for Saturday vigil Mass at 5:00 PM. Some weeks that may be a smaller schola of voices as we work to rebuild repertoire and voices. New singers are welcome to join. Rehearsals are at 4:00 PM before Mass during September with a midweek rehearsal still to be determined. You must be vaccinated to participate.

Saturday evening Mass will continue to be ASL interpreted each week.

**Sunday, 7:30 AM**. A cantor and piano will accompany our early Sunday Mass at 7:30 AM as has been our plan for some years. The music repertoire is the same as the other Masses but is led by one of our excellent cantors and piano accompanist.

**Sunday, 9:00 and 11:00 AM**. Our later Sunday morning Masses will return to being led by an ensemble of instruments and voices, including violin, flute, clarinet, acoustic and electric guitars, and piano. New singers are also welcome at either Mass with rehearsal at 8:00 AM and 10:30 AM respectively. You must be vaccinated to participate. Each week we send out a link to download and prepare music, so our Sunday rehearsals are efficient. A midweek rehearsal is still to be determined.

**Video production**. One of the blessings we have received during this pandemic is our ability to now livestream Masses, funerals, and special events. I want to particularly acknowledge Brant Crabbe who has assisted us on sound set up and video production during this time as well as Ann Barba from our staff, who has been our livestream tech on Saturday evenings. Steven Taylor has also joined our team of livestream techs who assist on Sundays.

## **Threads of Comfort**

"A Prayer Shawl breaks the barrier of loneness; it is a reminder that others care. A Prayer Shawl can fill the gap when words can fail. Stitch by stitch, thread by thread, each Prayer Shawl is woven with prayers: to bring comfort, hope and love."

Prayer Shawl stories: A woman, struggling through cancer treatments, told me, when she needed to remember to "breathe" she would grab her shawl. A gentleman told us when missing his wife, he would use her prayer shawl for a hug. A woman shared her prayer shawl with another friend, to pass on the prayers of comfort and hope she had experienced through her own operation. Parents who have lost a child - a prayer shawl silently wrapped them in a loving embrace. A hospice friend, blanketed with a Prayer Shawl a crossed her -No longer speaking, we watched her hand grip her shawl.

Two volunteers, working together, remove the granite niche cover, prepare the interior to receive the urn, and re-seal the niche following the prayer service. Burials take place Monday through Friday, between 12:00 and 3:00 PM.

**Cemetery Angels**: Cemetery Angels (an individual, couple, or family) choose one month to visit the cemetery twice during that month. They walk through removing dead flowers and alerting the cemetery manager of any issues requiring attention. Now accepting signups for months in 2022.
