

STEP 1 - REGISTER

STEP 2 - SET UP PAYMENT METHOD

- Now log into your account, click on MY PAYMENT METHOD.
- You will need to ADD NEW BANK ACCOUNT (if using your checking account) OR ADD NEW CREDIT CARD (if using your credit card).
- Provide all the information requested. Then click **SUBMIT**.

STEP 3 – SET UP DONATION

OPTIONS: You can choose multiple funds (RE, Building Maintenance, SVdP)

- Now return to MANAGE MY ACCOUNT and choose GIVE A NEW GIFT.
- Choose OFFERTORY (fund), then select gift type RECURRING.
- Select payment and frequency and start date.
- Select the account (check or credit card), then enter amount and frequency.
- Click **NEXT** (at the bottom of the page)
- In the **CONFIRM MY GIFTS** window, review the details to insure all is correct. Click **SUBMIT**.

Celebrating Baptisms within the Sunday Mass

This weekend we will celebrate the sacrament of Baptism for multiple children within the 9:00 and 11:00 AM Masses. This will be the first time since the beginning of the pandemic restrictions to gather family and community to baptize these infants into the faith at a regular Sunday Mass, which is the normative way to celebrate the sacrament. During these past 20 months individual baptisms have taken place at separate celebrations only attended by immediate family members.

This also marks our use the revised Rite of Baptism that was promulgated just prior to the pandemic. There are new translations of several texts and greetings in the revised rite, as well as a few changes in the ritual moments. Our opening song speaks to the importance of Baptism as a sign of God's grace in each of our lives.

Your Small Acts of Mercy have provided 117,000 sack lunches, family meals or hot breakfasts to our most vulnerable since April of 2020 and the start of the Covid-19 Pandemic. Mercy Teams supporters have now adopted



five missions we support on a weekly basis, with between 125 to 230 sack lunches to each one.

- Number of sack lunches delivered every week = 850.
- Total number of sacks we deliver once a month = 600.
- Total sack lunches in a 4-week month = 4.000

New Battle on Taxpayer Funding of Abortion

Efforts to save the Hyde Amendment are continuing, but now there's ANOTHER, huge battle shaping up over taxpayer funding of abortion.

Congress is moving forward on a "human infrastructure" bill, which is likely to include things that

many Catholics support, including expanded health care coverage. But there is serious concern that such health care proposals will include funding for elective abortion.

Congressional leadership is using a rare process for this bill, known as "budget reconciliation," that requires fewer votes to pass it than most laws.

Columbarium Burial Assistants: Sacred Heart Cemetery has volunteers to assist with cremation burials in our columbarium niches. We'd like to increase the team and rotate new helpers on the list. Two volunteers, working together, remove the granite niche cover, prepare the interior to receive the urn, and re-seal the niche following the prayer service. Burials take place Monday through Friday, between 12:00 and 3:00 PM.

Cemetery Angels: Cemetery Angels (an individual, couple, or family) choose one month to visit the cemetery twice during that month. They walk through removing dead flowers and alerting the cemetery manager of any issues requiring attention. Now accepting signups for months in 2022.
