



Welcomed Like Children

Taking a child, he placed it in their midst, and putting his arms around it, he said to them, "Whoever receives one child such as this in my name, receives me and whoever receives me, receives not me but the One who sent me." ~ Mark 9:36-37



Our children are gifts from God. How do we open the gift? Watch the face of any grandparent as a little one waddles first steps. See the deep joy of a mom or dad as a son or daughter competes in a sport or performs at recital or receives first Holy Communion or Confirmation or walks across a stage at graduation. In these special and in ordinary moments, we glimpse more than the child or the situation. We witness relationship.

In modern society children are treasured, protected, and their health and well-being are prioritized. Parents, grandparents, extended family members and close friends will go above and beyond to provide for their children. That was not the case in Jesus' time. Perhaps because of a high infant mortality rate, only a small percentage of children reached adulthood. So, as Jesus takes this child and places it in the midst of his disciples, he is giving emphasis and new value to a neglected member of the community.

Who Receives a Child, Receives Me

As Jesus tells them, "Whoever receives a child in my name, receives me," he declares that all humanity is made in the image of God. All ages and individuals deserve the same respect, love and care, as we intend for God. His message directly confronts the disciples in their arguing about who is the greatest. Moreover, it highlights the second prediction of his passion, death and resurrection. The apostles are too preoccupied with their own situation to pay enough attention to Jesus' meaning.

Whoever Wishes to Be First, Must Serve

If we desire to be disciples of Christ, then we must follow his example of servant leadership. Who are the individuals in your life who have also shown you by their example what true leadership is by the way they treat and honor everyone who comes into their life – children, youth, or adults? These "ordinary saints" deserve our respect by imitating their approach to the value of all relationships.

The Letter of St. James today reminds us clearly and adamantly, that if we want peace, we must cultivate peace. Especially in these current times of increased public animosity, disagreement on social matters, and other division, how are we welcoming others as we have been welcomed by our heavenly Father?



ONLINE GIVING IN 3 EASY STEPS

If you are already using online giving skip step 1 and 2. (if you forgot your user ID or password click the forgot button and a new password will be emailed to you.

STEP 1 - REGISTER

- From OLL website www.ollparish.com
- Click "Giving" in top right navigation bar
- Click on "Give Online via My Own Giving"
- Click on CREATE A NEW ACCOUNT.



• Submit. You will receive an email to confirm your information.

STEP 2 - SET UP PAYMENT METHOD

- Now log into your account, click on MY PAYMENT METHOD.
- You will need to ADD NEW BANK ACCOUNT (if using your checking account)
 OR ADD NEW CREDIT CARD (if using your credit card).
- Provide all the information requested. Then click **SUBMIT**.

STEP 3 – SET UP DONATION

OPTIONS: You can choose multiple funds (RE, Building Maintenance, SVdP)

- Now return to MANAGE MY ACCOUNT and choose GIVE A NEW GIFT.
- Choose **OFFERTORY** (fund), then select gift type **RECURRING**.
- Select payment and frequency and start date.
- Select the account (check or credit card), then enter amount and frequency.
- Click **NEXT** (at the bottom of the page)
- In the CONFIRM MY GIFTS window, review the details to insure all is correct.
 Click SUBMIT.

Threads of Comfort

"A Prayer Shawl breaks the barrier of loneness; it is a reminder that others care. A Prayer Shawl can fill the gap when words can fail. Stitch by stitch, thread by thread, each Prayer Shawl is woven with prayers: to bring comfort, hope and love."

Prayer Shawl stories: A woman, struggling through cancer treatments, told me, when she needed to remember to "breathe" she would grab her shawl. A gentleman told us when missing his wife, he would use her prayer shawl for a hug. A woman shared her prayer shawl with another friend, to pass on the prayers of comfort and hope she had experienced through her own operation. Parents who have lost a child - a prayer shawl silently wrapped them in a loving embrace. A hospice friend, blanketed with a Prayer Shawl across her -No longer speaking, we watched her hand grip her shawl.

Sacred Heart Cemetery Needs You

BURY THE DEAD: A CORPORAL WORK OF MERCY

During funerals, we mourn the loss of life. As Christians, we live in the hope of the Resurrection. Participate in this Corporal Work of Mercy by helping us some of the services we offer our parish community.

How You Can Help

Secretary, Cemetery Committee: Do you have a laptop? The Cemetery Committee is in need of a Secretary to attend quarterly meetings, take notes, and prepare meeting minutes.

Columbarium Burial Assistants: Sacred Heart Cemetery has volunteers to assist with cremation burials in our columbarium niches. We'd like to increase the team and rotate new helpers on the list. Two volunteers, working together, remove the granite niche cover, prepare the interior to receive the urn, and re-seal the niche following the prayer service. Burials take place Monday through Friday, between 12:00 and 3:00 PM.

Cemetery Angels: Cemetery Angels (an individual, couple, or family) choose one month to visit the cemetery twice during that month. They walk through removing dead flowers and alerting the cemetery manager of any issues requiring attention. Now accepting signups for months in 2022.
