Third Sunday of Advent

Our Reason for Hope

*God indeed is my savior; I am confident and unafraid.
My strength and my courage is the Lord, and he has been my savior.*
- Isaiah 12:2-3

Our Responsorial Psalm this Third Sunday of Advent (Gaudete: meaning *rejoice*) is actually not a psalm but a passage from the prophet Isaiah: *Cry out with joy and gladness: for among you is the great and Holy One of Israel.* (Is 12:6) Coupled with the first line from St. Paul's Letter to the Philippians: *Rejoice in the Lord always* (Phil 4:4) and the prophecy of Zephaniah in the first reading, the encouragement to "rejoice" shapes our Advent focus this year: *Be glad and rejoice with all your Heart. The Lord, your God, is in your midst.* (Zephaniah 3: 14.17)

What is our reason to rejoice, to take a hopeful outlook when our world seems so overwhelmed with suffering and sadness? We have hope because Jesus sent us the Holy Spirit to be with us – as Church – His visible and continuing presence in the world, and to guide us as a people until He comes again. Our Advent reflections remind us of and connect us to the whole arc of salvation history: God's covenant to be with us always.

What Should We Do?

In this Sunday's Gospel, the crowds ask John the Baptist, "What should we do?" St. John replies with ways to prepare

for the coming of the Messiah. We know historically that Jesus was born, lived and preached the commandments to love, was crucified, died but then was raised and will come again. How do we prepare for His Second Coming?

Pope Francis has called for the Church to hold a "synod" in the next several years and has invited Catholics all over the world to begin a dialogue to ask the very question that the earliest disciples asked of John the Baptist: *What should we do?* The Holy Father is inviting us to pray and consider how the Church should respond to the important issues of our current day and, in a spirit of "collegiality" to make recommendations. Every diocese will have an opportunity to provide input into this worldwide process.

Archbishop Sample has begun our Synod preparations locally with a call to pray. Beginning this weekend, we will pray the Synod prayer (see page 3) every month as the first step toward our personal and parish-wide discernment. Trusting that the Holy Spirit is leading us, *we are confident and unafraid.*

Prayer for the Synod on Synodality

Our Holy Father Pope Francis has invited the Catholic Church to embark on a journey together. Through listening and discernment rooted in the Holy Spirit, the entire people of God will be called to contribute to a process by which the Church deepens in understanding of Her mission and looks toward the future.

A Synod, which is the process by which the Church will begin this important work is not just a convening of Bishops reflecting on a particular topic and advising the Pope. A Synod is a journey of discernment, in which the people of God are called to pray and reflect upon the Holy Spirit's will for the Church. Through our listening and our sharing, we will seek to understand what the Holy Spirit's will is for the topic being discussed – and thus, for the Church.

For the 2023 Ordinary Synod of Bishops, that topic is synodality. Simply put, synodality is discerning how the Spirit is moving through and with the Body of Christ, so that we may continue to fulfill our mission to evangelize in the world. Here is the prayer for the synod which we will pray each month at Mass, and at parish meetings when possible. It is the same prayer that was used at each of the sessions of the Second Vatican Council.

We stand before You, Holy Spirit, as we gather together in Your name.

With You alone to guide us, make Yourself at home in our hearts;

Teach us the way we must go and how we are to pursue it.

We are weak and sinful; do not let us promote disorder.

Do not let ignorance lead us down the wrong path nor partiality influence our actions.

Let us find in You our unity so that we may journey together to eternal life and not stray from the way of truth and what is right.

All this we ask of You, who are at work in every place and time, in the communion of the Father and the Son, forever and ever.

Amen.

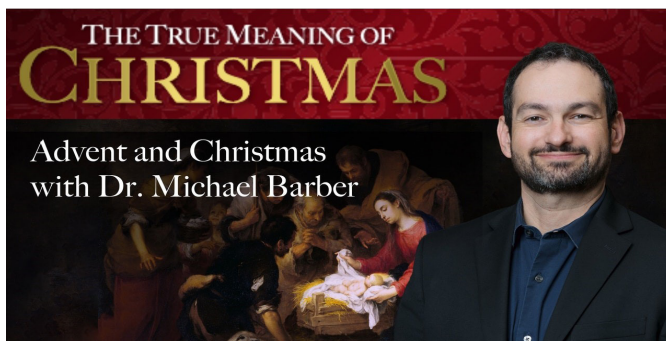
