The Divine Mercy

Thomas, called Didymus, one of the Twelve, was not with them when Jesus came. So the other disciples said to him, "We have seen the Lord." But he said to them, "Unless I see the mark of the nails in his hands and put my finger into the nail marks and put my hand into his side, I will not believe."

John 20:24-25

Like St. Thomas, my baptismal name saint, I often need to see to believe, need evidence to give my assent, and don't very willingly take someone else's word for truth. It is a hard fault for me to admit, but, also like St. Thomas, I am always grateful for the second chance to get it right. Jesus offers his Divine Mercy to St. Thomas as he invites him to touch his wounded hands and side:

Jesus – the Resurrected Christ – offers each of us his Divine Mercy, not just in this Easter season, but at all times. God's unconditional love and eternal mercy and forgiveness are available to each one of us if we would let go of our doubts and believe. Such an act of faith has become even more challenging in our current culture where truth and belief have become so relative to personal opinion.

Jesus, I Trust in You

St. Faustina Kowalska advocated devotion to The Divine Mercy. Her apparitions and image of Jesus' outpouring of mercy led to St. Pope John Paul II declaring this Sunday in the liturgical calendar as Divine Mercy Sunday in the Jubilee year 2000.

St. Faustina's simple yet profound prayer, "*Jesus, I trust in you,*" reminds of St. Thomas' act of faith: *My Lord and My God.*" The two main themes of the Divine Mercy devotion are to trust in Christ's endless goodness, and to show mercy to others acting as a conduit for God's love towards them.

In this challenging year, which continues to test our faith in so many additional ways, we particularly need the examples of St. Faustina and St. Thomas to remind us that we are surrounded and sustained by the Divine Mercy – if we can trust and believe. We can demonstrate our conviction by simple acts of kindness and forgiveness to others in our family, workplace, school, civic and online community. Mercy received begets mercy given.

Praying the Chaplet of Divine Mercy

This weekend is the Sunday of Divine Mercy. **The Chaplet of the Divine Mercy** is a devotion to the **Divine Mercy** based on the Christological apparitions of Jesus reported by Saint Faustina Kowalska (1905–1938), known as "the Apostle of **Mercy**." She was a Polish religious sister of the Congregation of the Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy and canonized as a Catholic saint in 2000 by then-Pope John Paul II.

How to Pray the Chaplet of Divine Mercy

Optional Opening Prayers:

- (1) You expired, Jesus, but the source of life gushed forth for souls, and the ocean of mercy opened up for the whole world.
- (2) O Fount of Life, unfathomable Divine Mercy, envelop the whole world and empty Yourself out upon us.

(Repeat 3 times) O Blood and Water, which gushed forth from the Heart of Jesus as a fountain of Mercy for us, I trust in You!

Our Father, Hail Mary and the Apostle's Creed

For each of the five decades

(On each "Our Father" bead of the rosary, pray)

Eternal Father, I offer you the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your Dearly Beloved Son, Our Lord, Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.

(On each of the 10 "Hail Mary" beads, pray)

For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

Concluding prayer *(Repeat 3 times)*

Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

Optional Closing Prayer

Eternal God, in whom mercy is endless and the treasury of compassion inexhaustible, look kindly upon us and increase Your mercy in us, that in difficult moments we might not despair nor become despondent, but with great confidence submit ourselves to Your holy will, which is Love and Mercy itself.

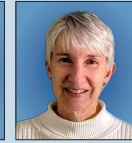

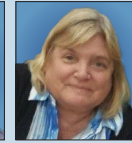

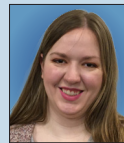
