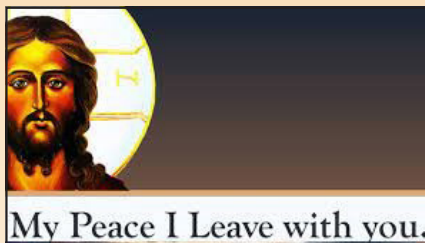

Helping in Ministry at Mass

Is the Holy Spirit calling you to serve?

As we approach the great feast of Pentecost when the first disciples received the Holy Spirit's call to go out and invite others to follow Jesus, is that same Holy Spirit inviting you to respond in a particular way to serve?

At each weekend Mass, 10-12 parishioners serve as sacristan, ushers, lectors, altar servers, and as Extraordinary Ministers of the Holy Eucharistic. Others serve in our music ministries, and others help set up our Art & Environment. Each of these roles is important to the life of our community and celebration of Mass.

During the pandemic and with a limited Mass schedule we needed fewer individuals to serve. Now, as we have full Mass schedule again on weekends and weekdays, we need more parishioners to step up to serve in these roles. Additionally, many of our older and more vulnerable parishioners have had to step back from participating in the liturgical ministries. It's time for the next generations to take their rightful place.

How Can You Help?

If you have previously served as a liturgical minister but are inactive, consider this a gentle nudge to jump back on the schedule. Your participation will lighten the load for some who now are serving every week to fill in the schedule. If you have never served as an usher, lector, or Eucharistic Minister, consider how serving might increase your participation in the Mass and deepen your relationship with our Lord. He is calling your name.

Ushers. We have the greatest need for ushers and greeters especially at all weekend Masses. This role is primarily about ensuring the safety of those gathering and providing a spirit of hospitality – especially to many parishioners returning to Mass.

Eucharistic Ministers. Many people consider themselves “unworthy” to serve in this special ministry. But remember Jesus' response to Peter when he refused to let him wash his feet. We are all unworthy except for our salvation in Christ. You will never have a greater appreciation for the Holy Eucharist than in service to others.

Altar Servers. Youth in 5th grade and older are invited to become altar servers. We will be offering several training times in the coming weeks. If you have previously served and need a refresher or would like to be trained to serve, please contact tomt@ollparish.com and we will be in touch with further information.

Scheduling and Training. Our online Ministry Scheduler makes it very convenient to accept an assignment or ask for a substitute if your schedule changes. It can also set up particular service times for certain Masses. We offer training for ALL ministries or you can “shadow” a current minister to see if it is a good fit for you.
