Responding to Christ in Mission

The disciples rejoiced when they saw the Lord. Jesus said to them again, "Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I send you." And when he had said this, he breathed on them and said, "Receive the Holy Spirit."

Acts 1:10-11

On Pentecost we hear St. John's account of Jesus' appearance to the disciples after His resurrection, greeting them with a message of peace, and reminding of their relationship with the Father through his union with the Father. The Risen Christ's message of peace reminds us of the same greeting given by the angels to the shepherds at Jesus' birth. The world needs the hope of peace more than ever.

On Pentecost the first disciples were given the "great commission" to proclaim the Good News and sent forth with the gift of the Holy Spirit. That same Holy Spirit still guides us—the Church—and sends us to be witnesses to God's mercy and love. In last weekend's homily, Fr. John reminded us that when we gather in the name of the Lord for Mass the Body of Christ is truly present and we participate in His mission.

The Mission of God Has a Church

Being "sent on mission" can sound like so much theological language that we lose the practical application of what it means in our daily lives. We usually hear that as: *The Church has a mission.* However, it may be more instructive to

understand that *God's Mission has a Church!* Each one of us has that capacity to fulfill the mission—regardless of our age—to bring the Good News to the world. Each of us has a "circle of influence" to reach out to friends, family, and those we encounter in our daily lives at school, work, and through social interactions.



A Spirituality of Abundance

We are often quick to discount our own capacity and talents to serve others. But when we consider all the spiritual gifts we have been given—compassion, listening, organizing, caring, courage, creativity and so on—we are *abundantly blessed*. In his homily at our Confirmation Mass

two weeks ago, Archbishop Emeritus John Vlazny reminded the youth that they would receive the Holy Spirit's seven-fold gifts. However, the greatest gift they could share is God's gift of love. Simply put, when we reach out in love and service to our family, friends, and the greater community, we respond to Christ in mission using our gifts—breathed on us by the Holy Spirit.

Pentecost Sequence

On special liturgical occasions including Pentecost and Easter, we sing a "Sequence" a musical poem, as a reflection before the proclamation of the Gospel. In the Middle Ages there were many sequences, but in our current Roman Missal, only two are required. Here is the text for Pentecost which we will sing this weekend:

Veni, Sancte Spiritus (Come, Holy Spirit)

*Come, Holy Spirit, come!
And from your celestial home
Shed a ray of light divine!
Come, Father of the poor!
Come, source of all our store!
Come, within our bosoms shine.*

*You, of comforters the best;
You, the soul's most welcome guest;
Sweet refreshment here below;
In our labor, rest most sweet;
Grateful coolness in the heat;
Solace in the midst of woe.*

*O most blessed Light divine,
Shine within these hearts of yours,
And our inmost being fill!
Where you are not, we have naught,
Nothing good in deed or thought,
Nothing free from taint of ill.*

*Heal our wounds, our strength renew;
On our dryness pour your dew;
Wash the stains of guilt away:
Bend the stubborn heart and will;
Melt the frozen, warm the chill;
Guide the steps that go astray.*

*On the faithful, who adore
And confess you, evermore
In your sevenfold gift descend;
Give them virtue's sure reward;
Give them your salvation, Lord;
Give them joys that never end. Amen.
Alleluia.*

this is my Adventure

Dear Friends & Family,

I wanted to share some exciting news with you! I am set to graduate from Carroll College with a Bachelor of Science in Nursing and a Minor in Spanish on May 14, 2022. This is bitter sweet as I have had the best four years of my life at Carroll. I will be sad to say goodbye to this place and these people who have had such a huge impact on my life. However, I am looking forward to taking the next step into this exciting adventure that the Lord is calling me to!



Over the past four years in college, I started to develop a restlessness in my heart and a shift in my desires. The Lord provided me with many opportunities throughout college which strengthened my desire for people to know that they are seen, known, and loved. I have witnessed a deep loneliness that people from all different walks of life are experiencing. People are thirsting for presence. For instance, I saw it in the people experiencing homelessness on the streets of Denver when I volunteered with Christ in the City. And I see it every day in the sophomore girls on my floor as a peer minister in a college dorm. Last summer, during a weeklong FOCUS mission trip to the Dominican Republic, I felt the Lord calling me to step into something bigger. Specifically, to step out of my comfortable lifestyle and to enter into a simple, yet radical, lifestyle as a missionary. The Lord is calling me to meet people at the foot of the cross and walk with them in their suffering as a missionary. I pray that I can be a vessel of the love that God has for all of us.

I will spend 16 months serving as a volunteer nurse and teacher at a family-style Catholic orphanage called Farm of the Child in rural Trujillo, Honduras. The Farm of the Child, "Finca del Niño," is a community which serves 40 orphaned children as well as 200 families in the surrounding mountain villages. At the Farm, these children who have survived poverty, abandonment, and difficult family situations, now receive a good education at the school, health care at the clinic, spiritual formation, and love, provided by international volunteers and Honduran house parents. I know that I will receive so many blessings through my work with the people of Honduras which will officially begin in October 2022 after 6 weeks of language school in Guatemala.

I would like to invite you to join me in this new mission as well! First and foremost I ask for your support through prayers for the children of the Farm and the good work being done there, and also for myself as I prepare for this upcoming year of service.

Additionally, I am in need of financial support to make this mission possible. As unpaid volunteers, we are asked to raise \$9,000 which will go directly toward supporting our work, which includes basic living expenses, health insurance, language school, and transportation, as well as the expenses of the orphanage. Any extra funds I raise will go directly to supporting the clinic. It would mean a great deal to me if you would consider making a gift to the Farm of the Child in support of my medical volunteer work.

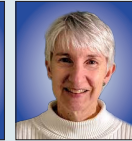

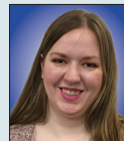

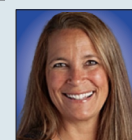
