Contemplation and Action

"Lord, do you not care that my sister has left me by myself to do the serving? Tell her to help me." The Lord said to her in reply, "Martha, Martha, you are anxious and worried about many things. There is need of only one thing. Mary has chosen the better part and it will not be taken from her."

Luke 10: 40-42

artha and Mary have become the classic figures in the Church representing two different styles of life, the active and the contemplative vocation, an active ministry, or a life of prayer. Jesus reminds Martha

that *both* prayer and hospitality are needed. No active apostolate can thrive unless it grows out of a life of prayer, for we cannot draw others to the knowledge and love of a God whom we do not ourselves know and love. Nor can a life of prayer be genuine unless it leads to care for others and concern for the salvation of all those whom the Lord loves.

I often summarize these two dimensions of the faith as balancing the importance of "going to church" and "being church." We need the grounding of prayer with the community on Sundays, but we also need practical applications of our Christian beliefs. Never was that

more apparent at OLL than during the pandemic shutdown when we could only meet for worship by livestream, but simultaneously contributed to the "meals of mercy" as families driving up to the parish on Sundays with carloads of sack lunches or generous food and financial donations for St. Vincent de Paul.

The Gift of Hospitality

Last Sunday, Kimi and I had the opportunity to visit our former parish back in Wisconsin as we finally travelled back to visit relatives and friends we haven't seen since the start of the pandemic. Our parish there was always a very welcoming congregation and we noticed again, as visitors now, that "spirit of hospitality" manifested not just in the ushers and greeters but also in the members of the assembly. Over the years they have come to understand the importance of reaching out to those who might be new or visiting,

returning to the faith, or someone dealing with a difficult moment in their life and in need of God's care and healing in a particular way.

I wondered how visitors experience our community at Our Lady of the Lake. I know we try to be open, welcoming, and inviting. In truth, we might never know the story of the stranger in our midst, but we can offer the hospitality of a friendly greeting, a caring smile, or offer to come to fellowship after Mass. Like Abraham in our first reading, we will surely be blessed by our willingness to reach out to those in



The Mystery Hidden from Ages

St Paul reminds the early community at Colossae that, as disciples, active in living the faith, they are revealing a "mystery hidden from ages" as they proclaim Christ through their suffering endurance and in their caring for others. Our proclamation of the faith needs no words most times but rather the visibility of our actions and attitudes. St. Francis was remembered for saying, "Preach the Gospel at all times, and when necessary, use words." It is a message to ponder, especially in these days when words are too often used as weapons in social and broadcast media. May we, like St. Francis exemplified, instead be instruments of God's peace.

Live in the Presence of the Lord

ne of the gifts of the Second Vatican Council was the restoration of singing the psalms as part of the Liturgy of the Word. In addition to scripture readings from the Hebrew scriptures, and from the Epistles and Gospels, we sing or recite the psalms at each Mass. The lyric and metric qualities of the psalms afford us an opportunity to reflect more deeply on the scriptural lessons, the Word of God, we hear proclaimed.

This week, we are invited to pray Psalm 15 and reflect on the complementary tasks of action and contemplation. As disciples we are grounded by our prayer which leads us to action for justice. They are the two feet that help us walk in the presence of the Lord. We will sing a new Gospelstyled setting of the psalm by local composer, Ken Canedo, during the Communion rite at Mass in addition to as the responsorial psalm.

He who does justice will live in the presence of the Lord.


Sign Up for Sunday After-Mass Hospitality


WHO AM I TO JUDGE? WITH DR. EDWARD SRI -DON'T IMPOSE YOUR MORALITY ON ME!
