## Welcome Fr. Charles Zach

**T**his week, Fr. Charles Zach arrived at Our Lady of the Lake to begin serving as our new Parochial Vicar.

Fr. Charles—as he prefers to be called—most recently served as pastor of St. Henry Parish in Gresham for the past thirteen years and prior to that was pastor of St. Helen, Junction City and St. Rose in Monroe, Oregon for seven years. This year marks twenty years of service as a priest of the Archdiocese of Portland, but that is only half of Fr. Charles' priesthood story.

Born in Winnebago, Nebraska as one of twelve children of Henry and Gertrude Zach, Fr. Charles attended St. Augustine Indian Mission Elementary School there and Mt. Michael Benedictine High School (St. John Vianney Seminary.) He achieved a Bachelor of Science degree at Benedictine College in Kansas and later a Master of Science from Oregon State University. Yes, Fr. Charles was an OSU Beaver! Those years likely planted the seed of his later relationship with our state and Archdiocese.

Fr. Charles completed his master's in theology at St. John University in Minnesota in 1973 and became a fully professed monk at Mount Michael Abbey in Elkhorn, Nebraska. He was ordained a priest in 1973. As part of his monastic service in the Abbey, from 1979 until 2001 he taught biology, chemistry, theology, Latin and served as Dean of Students, Athletic Director and, eventually, as Administrator and Development Director of his alma mater, Mt. Michael Benedictine High School for 25 years. Along the way he added post-graduate studies at the University of Iowa, Nebraska, Creighton, and Oregon State in School Administration.

### A Life Called to Service

During the summers, as a needed pastoral break from

academia, Fr. Charles served as a “help-out” priest at parishes near Eugene and the coast. In 2002, after prayerful discernment, Fr. Charles sought incardination into the Archdiocese of Portland. This is the canonical process by which an ordained priest transfers obedience from one diocese to another, or, in this case, from his professed vows to the Benedictine Abbot in Nebraska, to the local Ordinary, at the time, Archbishop John Vlazny.



Friends with Fr. Kerns, having met during those summers in Oregon, the two priests began talking about a potential role and residency here at Our Lady of the Lake following his pending retirement in June. Fr. Charles desired to keep serving in parish ministry but hoped to “not be in charge” with responsibilities as pastor. We are now the beneficiaries of his continued commitment to pastoral service and look forward to his preaching, presiding, and presence in the coming years.

Fr. Charles lists reading, golf, sports, photography, bridge/pinocle, Native American lore, medicine, mythology, traveling, Spanish language, and liturgical and classical music as some of his diverse interests.

### Come Meet and Welcome Fr. Charles

Parishioners are invited to welcome Fr. 
