## Serving, Praying, and Sharing 2022

Psalm 117

God has a plan for this world. He wants the message of salvation through his Son Jesus Christ to reach the ears of every human person, and to spiritually transform every soul. This has always been God's plan, even during the pandemic. How does God accomplish that plan? Through all of us. Through our service and prayer, and through our ministries made possible by your financial support of our parish. As our OLL Parish Mission states:

### **Love God • Love Others • Make Disciples of Jesus Christ**

We live that mission out by *Serving, Praying* and *Sharing*. We *Serve* by getting involved in parish activities for spiritual growth, faith formation, retreats, and when we minister to other parishioners at Mass or in the office, or even assist those we may never meet who are served through St. Vincent de Paul or our Mercy Teams Sack Lunch Program. We *Pray* when we gather for Mass on Sunday, or daily and at School Masses, and when we gather in small prayer groups or offer our own private devotions. We *Share* when we support our parish financially, when we serve a meal to someone who is homeless, or through our support of other organizations with our Outreach Fund (3% of our Offertory).

Today, in this letter, I need to focus on our monetary gifts. I am proud of how our parish pursued our mission during COVID and grateful for your continued contributions during difficult times. Still, our income has definitely dipped. Currently, we remain behind budget, especially due to this year's larger than average cost of living salary increase nationally, and a 20% rise in our insurance and utilities. Over the years we have limited staffing by natural attrition and reorganization to control costs.

Therefore, at this time, I need to ask you to consider increasing your contributions so that we can meet our 2022-2023 budget by the end of the fiscal year. I understand that some parishioners have had downturns in their income and may need to cut back. But here I am letting you know what our needs are so that you can adjust your support of the parish as you are able. (See budget projections on the back side.) If you give \$20/week, can you give \$25? If you give \$50/week, can you give \$60? If you give \$100/week, can you give \$120. One way you can augment your gift is through online giving or automatic bank transfers.

Psalm 116 says: *How can I make a return to the Lord for all the good he has done for me?* To be a steward means to recognize that everything I have is a gift from God that has been placed in my care for the good of my household and for others. Therefore, in a spirit of gratitude I am called to make a commitment to give back to God—for the sake of God's mission—a portion (percentage) of what I have received.

Thank you in advance for your commitment to Our Lady of the Lake Catholic Church. May God bless you and your loved ones.

## FISCAL YEAR 2021-2022 PARISH MISSION HIGHLIGHTS

Maintaining our parish mission to *Love God. Love Others. Make Disciples of Jesus Christ* from July 1, 2021, through June 30, 2022, was challenging as we emerged from Covid restrictions and gradually resumed programs, outreach, and liturgical services. We registered 98 new families for a total of 1,571 active parish families. Our parish continues to experience growth despite family transitions.

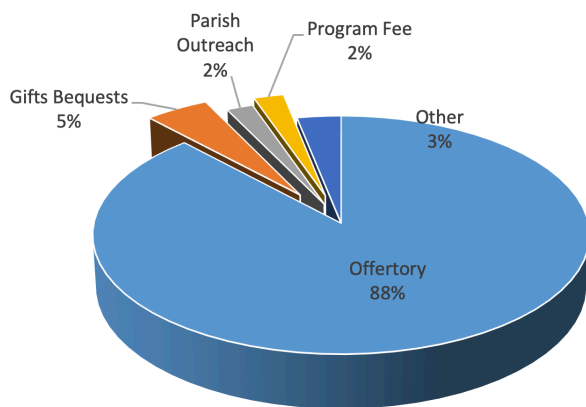
**Mass Participation:** Attendance at the four weekend Masses averaged 750 in-person, half the pre-Covid numbers, with an average of 300 unique views of livestream Mass joining each week through online syndications. Our online giving increases helped to reduce the substantial loss of weekend offertory collections.

**Faith Formation, Sacraments, and Retreats:** Staff resumed Children, Family, Youth and Adult Faith Formation offered through a combination of online and in-person events. There were 89 Baptisms, 140 First Communions, 103 Confirmations, 32 Marriages, and 25 adults become Catholic through the RCIA. We held ACTS retreats for both men and women, and parish Men's and Women's retreats which were all full and brought a new energy to parish life. 275 children were enrolled in our K-8th grade parish school.

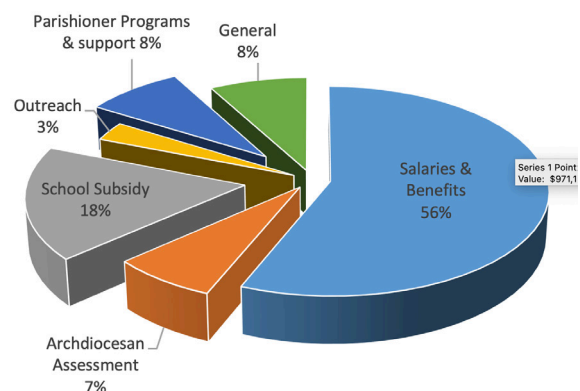
**Outreach:** Parishioners responded generously to our Mercy Teams sack lunch distributions, and St. Vincent de Paul food, utilities, and housing efforts. 3% of offertory was allocated to our Outreach Fund grants to deserving partner organizations. The Pastoral Council offered three special events to bring greater awareness to aspects of Catholic Social Teaching.

**Staff and Facilities:** COVID cleaning expenses stretched our budget as our 9 full-time and 5 part-time staff members adapted and maintained programs and services throughout the year.

## 2022-2023 BUDGET AND INCOME PROJECTIONS

**Our 2021-2022** parish operating income, which included offertory pledges, gifts, and donations to outreach and program service fees, was \$1,793,340. Our expenses for the year were \$1,921,947 on a budget of \$1,844,021, resulting in a loss of \$128,608. Most of the unexpected expenses were due to COVID-related maintenance and cleaning costs. Our normal expenses included personnel costs, services to parishioners, facilities, and outreach. To balance the budget last year, we had to dip into our savings, which decreased our available reserves.

**Our 2022-2023** budget expenses continue to rise, with an overall 8% increase over last year's budget. Major increases include personnel (cost of living raises), insurance and utilities (20% increase), technology and building maintenance. We are counting on a \$277,555 increase in income to balance this year's budget. With your increased financial support, we can meet our 2022-2023 budget and end the year in good financial shape as we continue to maintain and grow our parish mission.
