## Mary: Our Blessed Mother


Jesus said, "I will not leave you orphans; I will come to you. In a little while the world will no longer see me, but you will see me, because I live, and you will live."

John 14: 18–19

n these Sunday Gospels in the Easter Season, we hear how Jesus prepares his disciples for his Ascension into heaven and return to the Father, and the coming of the Holy Spirit to be with them (and us) until his coming in glory. In today's Gospel from St. John, the Holy Spirit is named "Advocate" (from the Latin *ad-vocare*—to "call to one's side") whom Jesus says will be with us through all time.

In Jesus' discourse with the disciples at the Last Supper recalled by St. John, the Holy Spirit is also the Advocate (in Greek "Paraclete") who will be sent by Jesus and the Father; will teach the disciples everything and lead them to the truth; and will give witness to the Father and the Son when Jesus is no longer physically present. The passage gives us not only the beginnings of the

theology of the Holy Trinity, but also a lasting confidence that Jesus is never absent from his Church.



We also hear in St. John's Gospel that Jesus, while on the cross and before his last breath, gave the apostle his Blessed Mother—and by extension to the Church through John as *our* mother for all time. What an amazing gift!

On this Mother's Day weekend, when we honor our own mothers and the women who have nurtured us in life, we might also take time to honor Mary, our Blessed Mother. We don't hear too much directly about Mary in the scriptures after that moment at the foot of the cross, but surely, she must have rejoiced and grieved and "pondered in her heart" with all the disciples the events in those early years of the Church's growth. Can you imagine a better "advocate" for

your prayers than Jesus' own mother? Mary accompanies us in our daily walk as her Son's disciples.

#### May—the Month of Mary

The Church has traditionally honored Mary, as our Blessed Mother particularly in the month of May. As our parish is named in honor of Mary, she has a special place in our life

and mission. Our parish's name also reflects Jesus' gift of her advocacy since our original parish name, "Sacred Heart," became Mary, Our Lady of the Lake. Last week, our OLL students crowned Mary at their Thursday school Mass, as they do each year, and brought flowers to her statues in church and in our courtyard between the campus buildings. It was a beautiful celebration in Mary's honor.

My own mom, Emilie, had a great devotion to our Blessed Mother and passed that prayer practice to all of us children. She traveled the Oregon Trail and came to live with us for the last ten years of her life. They were blessed years and moments that Kimi and I shared with her. The rosary beads were always in her hands and accompanied Emilie through her final days including her last breath as we prayed the rosary at her bedside. I have no doubt—in faith—that Our Blessed Mother greeted her as she went to God. It was a great comfort in that moment and a life

# Community SURVEY

ur Pastoral Council is conducting an OLL Community Survey to better understand the needs of our members and the community at large. All parishioners are invited to participate. The survey is the second component of our annual stewardship effort focusing on how we contribute our time, talent, and financial support to the parish.

WHEN: The survey has begun and is available online through May 18. Parishioners and those who chose to opt-in on a one-time basis received an email with a link to this special opportunity for feedback. (If you did not receive you can still participate by clicking the link on the parish website homepage.) Thanks for your prompt response. Those who complete the survey will have their email entered into a drawing for one of five \$100 gift certificates to local restaurants.

**HOW**: Our pastor, Fr. John Kerns, and our parish staff have engaged Vista Market Intelligence, a customer research firm led by OLL parishioner David Ludwig, to conduct the survey, working with parish staff and members of the

Pastoral Council Stewardship Committee in design and implementation. We are grateful for Vista's contributed services in managing the survey process and resulting reports.

WHY: Our goal is to hear how Our Lady of the Lake Parish can better serve our members, particularly in the areas of liturgy, prayer, and faith formation. We want to understand how these areas of parish life affect all parishioners, but particularly young families and those who have disengaged from parish life and activity. Learning about current needs, concerns, barriers, and life experiences of these parishioners and families will allow the Pastoral Council and our staff members to plan more effective response to these families, adapt future programs and services, and to reach out to children, youth, adults, seniors, and families in supportive ways.

Thank you for taking the time to participate in the OLL Community Survey. We cannot know how to grow as a parish and more effectively proclaim the Gospel of Our Lord, Jesus Christ, without listening to the *living* Body of Christ.
