Many Gifts, One Body of Christ

Brothers and sisters: There are different kinds of spiritual gifts but the same Spirit; there are different forms of service but the same Lord; there are different workings but the same God who produces all of them in everyone.

1 Corinthians 12:4-6

n Pentecost we hear St. John's Gospel account of Jesus' appearance to the disciples after His resurrection, greeting them with "*Peace be with you*" and reminding of their relationship with the Father through *his* union with the Father. The Risen Christ's message of

peace reminds us of the same greeting given by the angels to the shepherds at Jesus' birth. The world needs the hope of peace more than ever.

On Pentecost the first disciples were given the "great commission" to proclaim the Good News and sent forth with the gift of the Holy Spirit. That same Holy Spirit still guides us—the Church—and sends us to be witnesses to God's mercy and love. In last weekend's homily, Fr. John reminded us that when we gather in the name of the Lord for Mass the Body of Christ is truly present and we participate in His mission.

Different Gifts, Same Spirit

In his letter to the church at Corinth, St. Paul provides a blueprint for how the "church" is to accomplish its mission to proclaim Christ to the world. Each one of us baptized in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit has a *unique* set of abilities and talents—"gifts" given to us at our birth. No one else has exactly our combination of aptitudes which the Holy Spirit has endowed us with specifically. As we grow and develop those talents, we have the opportunity to share those gifts "in the name of the Lord" and for the good of others. The work of the church needs *all* these gifts to prosper.

Pentecost is a good occasion to take stock of our stewardship of these God-given talents. We usually think about service in

terms of visible church ministries at Mass, or faith formation, or outreach—and of course, we do need many people to make the parish function. But when we consider all the spiritual gifts and abilities we have been given—compassion, listening, organizing, caring, courage, creativity and so on—we are

abundantly blessed with abilities which may serve others.

Renew the Face of the Earth

Being "sent on mission" can sound like so much theological language that we lose the practical application of what it means in our daily lives. We usually hear that as: *The Church has a mission*. However, it may be more instructive to understand that *God's Mission has a Church!* Each one of us has that capacity to fulfill the mission—regardless of our age—to bring the Good News to the world. Each of us has a "circle of influence" to reach out to friends,

family, and those we encounter in our daily lives at school, work, and through social interactions.

In his homily at our Confirmation Mass, Archbishop Emeritus John Vlazny reminded the youth that they would receive the Holy Spirit's seven-fold gifts. However, the greatest gift they could share is God's gift of love to make a difference in the world. Simply put, when we reach out in love and service to our family, friends, and the greater community, we become the Body of Christ in mission using our gifts—breathed on us by the Holy Spirit—to renew the face of the earth.

One Sacrifice of Christ

n special liturgical occasions including Pentecost and Easter, we sing a "Sequence" a musical poem, as a reflection before the proclamation of the Gospel. In the Middle Ages there were many sequences, but in our current Roman Missal, only two are required. Here is the text for Pentecost which we will sing this weekend:

Veni, Sancte Spiritus (Come, Holy Spirit)

Come, Holy Spirit, come! And from your celestial home Shed a ray of light divine! Come, Father of the poor! Come, source of all our store! Come, within our bosoms shine.

You, of comforters the best; You, the soul's most welcome guest; Sweet refreshment here below; In our labor, rest most sweet; Grateful coolness in the heat; Solace in the midst of woe. O most blessed Light divine, Shine within these hearts of yours, And our inmost being fill! Where you are not, we have naught, Nothing good in deed or thought, Nothing free from taint of ill.

Heal our wounds, our strength renew; On our dryness pour your dew; Wash the stains of guilt away: Bend the stubborn heart and will; Melt the frozen, warm the chill; Guide the steps that go astray.

On the faithful, who adore And confess you, evermore In your sevenfold gift descend; Give them virtue's sure reward; Give them your salvation, Lord; Give them joys that never end. Amen. Alleluia.






Buy a Brick—Build a Legacy—Order by June 23

The month of May is not only the month we celebrate our Mothers that gave us life but also our dearest Mother Mary and all that blooms and flourishes. This month the Spanish Classroom that is blessed to be filled with light and sunshine coming from our large top floor corner windows has been highlighting the importance of the intention we put into our words, even if they are words in the Spanish language. As we pray to our Mother Mary the "Dios te Salve Maria" we put our heart into it as we gaze to the beautiful image of Our Lady of Guadalupe that hangs high on one of our main walls. In the spirit of the intention we put into words we started a beautiful experiment with seeds and the power of our words. We planted seeds into jars with dirt. We are seeing how powerful our words have an effect of the little seeds growing and we are witnessing how much our love can make even little seeds start to grow!


