Let the Little Children Come to Me

"Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of God belongs to such as these." - Mark 10:14

he return of Children's Liturgy of the Word each Sunday at 9am Mass and a successful Vacation Bible School this summer served as a renewal of our Children and Family Ministries. Here is an overview of those programs and an invitation to register.

First Sacraments Preparation

Our First Sacraments preparation will again use the engaging curriculum *"Signs of Grace."* New this year, parents with their children will meet in person each week where classroom leaders offer instruction and facilitate discussion. This unites the process of bringing children into the sacramental life

of the Church while building and strengthening our greater faith community. The first of 23 Sunday sessions begin on October 1st at 10am. Registration is open now through September 18 at: <u>ollparish.com/first-</u> sacraments/.

Life Kids Faith Formation Returns

The Catechism of the Catholic

Church states, "Parents have the first responsibility for the education of their children." Our parish is here to enhance your efforts. Life Kids is a 23 week in-person program that runs October 1 through May 5. Students will meet in the parish school building Sundays from 10:15 to 11:00am. "Word of Life" is the amazing curriculum that we will use for grades K-5th and the preschool class will be using the curriculum called "Allelu!" Classroom discussions, Bible stories, and group activities provide opportunities for youth to grow in faith and morals. Children's Liturgy of the Word

Children's Liturgy of the Word occurs weekly during 9am Mass. After the Opening Prayer, teachers and children gather and are sent forth with a blessing by the community. During

this 20-minute program in the hall, they hear the Sunday scriptures explained in ways that they can grasp and through song and craft activities. After the Prayer of the Faithful, the children rejoin their families. This program has proven popular, and we'd love to extend this program to the 11am Mass, but we need more volunteer instructors. Please pray that this need be filled.

Family Faith Events

Jesus said, *"For where two or three are gathered in my name, there am I among them."* (Matthew 18:20). Family Faith Events are one place to find Jesus amongst our community. Sprinkled

throughout the year, these events are fun and engaging ways for members of our parish to seek and offer fellowship, encouragement, and support in our Christian walk. We hope to see you at our Summer Social next Sunday, September 10 after the 9am Mass.

Children's Nursery: Ages 6 months to 3 years

Last summer, the OLL School completed a renovation to create a pre-Kindergarten

room on the lower level near the school entrance. That wonderful space will now also serve as our Children's Nursery beginning September 10, on Sundays from 8:15am to 12:15pm. We will offer adults attending Mass the opportunity to focus more on the liturgy while welcoming the little ones to spiritual nourishment in the nursery.

Parish Adult Leaders Needed

The parish requires an adult from each student's family to volunteer for classroom leadership at least four times a year. We would love to augment this parent team with parishioners called to serve as classroom assistants and guides. 

Sunday Mass Time Will Change on October 1st

On Sunday, October 1, 2023, the 11:00am Sunday Mass will begin at 11:15am each week. Prior to the pandemic shutdown, our Sunday morning Mass schedule was set at 7:30am, 9:00am, and 11:30am. At that time, we also offered a 5:00pm Sunday evening Life Teen Mass followed by our high school youth ministry and Confirmation programs. Those programs now meet at other times.

Reason for the Change

Parishioners will recall that we had adjusted the late Sunday morning time from 11:00am to 11:30am to provide sufficient time between the 9 and 11am Masses for our Life Kids, First Sacraments preparation, and Middle School faith formation programs. These sessions typically take an hour to check in the children, hold the lessons for 30-40 minutes, and then release children back to their parents. The later start to Mass allowed catechists and parents leading the "Sunday School" programs the opportunity to attend the later Mass. We also offered a variety of adult faith formation programs during the "Focus on Faith" hour between the Masses.

Life Kids and Confirmation

On October 1st, our Life Kids children and family faith formation and Middle School ministry will begin meeting in-person again from 10:15- 11:00am each Sunday. Our 8th and 9th grade youth and older teens seeking Confirmation will attend the now - 11:15am Mass twice a month and meet afterwards for lunch and sacramental preparation. Our staff suggests that only a fifteen-minute adjustment to the later Mass time is needed. So, we will make the change to 11:15am and monitor how things flow. Thank you for your patience and understanding as we revive these important catechetical efforts.
