Pastoral Council

"Again, amen, I say to you, if two of you agree on earth about anything for which they are to pray, it shall be granted to them by my heavenly Father. For where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them."

– Matthew 18:19-20

In this week's Gospel, Jesus assures the disciples that when they gather and act in His name, He is with us. The Pastoral Council of Our Lady of the Lake Parish for 2023-24 will be commissioned on Sunday, September 10, 2023, at the 9am Mass.

What does Pastoral Council do?

As stated in our Bylaws, "the purpose of the Pastoral Council is to help the Pastor in fostering pastoral activities in support of the mission of the Parish." What is the mission of our Parish? **Love God. Love Others. Make Disciples of Jesus Christ.**

We use the word "pastoral" frequently in church circles. What does it mean? An initial definition is "of or relating to shepherds." A more specifically Catholic answer will include "emulating Jesus Christ as a shepherd; how He leads us; how He acts; the dispositions of His Sacred Heart." As a Pastoral Council, we exist to help our shepherds, Father John, and Father Charles, to identify needs and plan, improve, review, and evaluate parish programs and services.

The Pastoral Council has been active this past year in discussing with Father John and parish leadership issues such as the Archdiocesan guidelines on church teaching on gender identity theory, and the recently completed parish community survey. The Council also receives regular updates on the activities of the Administrative Council and the Facilities and Development Committee. It's important to know that the specified role of the Council is "to advise", not to decide. Council members are called to be the voice of all parishioners, reflecting what they hear "in the pews" and in conjunction with the many ministries of our parish.

Who is on Pastoral Council?

Ten lay members and four staff comprise the Pastoral Council. Lay members reflect ministries both specifically and generally. This year the Council Chair is **Antoinette Awuakye-Green** (School Administration Council; Catholic Social Justice Initiative). **Mike McCallum** serves as Vice Chair (Liturgical Ministry, Small Groups) and **Joe Prats** is the Secretary (Mercy Teams, OCIA). **Laurens**

Johansen (Music Ministry), **Nina Pascua** (Liturgical Ministry, Mercy Teams), and **Molly McWeeney** (Hospitality) are back for another year on Council. They are joined this year by **Francine Heffernan** (Hospitality), **Cynthia Barr** (ACTS), and **Lillian Oppenheimer** (Adult Faith Formation).

The Council says goodbye to three highly talented and extraordinarily dedicated members, **Scott Olsen**

(Chair), **Mary Beth Horton** (Past Chair) and **Phil Barr** (Knights of Columbus). These three provided exceptional professionalism and key leadership over the past several years. Thank you for your service!

Staff members of the Pastoral Council are **Father John Kerns** (Pastor), **Father Charles Zach** (Parochial Vicar), **Tom Tomaszek** (Pastoral Associate), and **Laura Patton** (Director Adult Faith Formation). **Melissa Hanifan** (Coordinator of Children and Family Faith Formation) serves as a representative from the Archdiocesan Pastoral Council.

Sunday Mass Time Will Change on October 1st

On Sunday, October 1, 2023, the 11:00am Sunday Mass will begin at 11:15am each week. Prior to the pandemic shutdown, our Sunday morning Mass schedule was set at 7:30am, 9:00am, and 11:30am.

Reason for the Change

Parishioners will recall that we had adjusted the late Sunday morning time from 11:00am to 11:30am to provide sufficient time between the 9 and 11 am Masses for our Life Kids, First Sacraments preparation, and Middle School faith formation programs. These sessions typically take an hour to check in the children, hold the lessons for 30-40 minutes, and then release children back to their parents. The later start to Mass allowed catechists and parents leading the "Sunday School" programs the opportunity to attend the later Mass.

Life Kids and Confirmation

On October 1st, our Life Kids and Middle School ministry will begin meeting in-person again from 10:15 - 11:00am each Sunday. Our 8th and 9th grade youth and older teens seeking Confirmation will attend the now 11:15am Mass twice a month and meet afterwards for lunch and sacramental preparation. Thank you for your patience and understanding as we revive these important catechetical efforts.

Liturgical Ministers Needed

We are grateful for the liturgical ministers who have continued to serve as lectors, sacristans, ushers, altar servers, and Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion. We simply need more parishioners to serve! Here is an open call – especially to younger parishioners – to serve in one of these ministries.

Ushers. We need ushers for all weekend Masses. This role is primarily about providing a spirit of hospitality – especially to many parishioners returning to Mass and visitors.

Eucharistic Ministers. Many people consider themselves "unworthy" to serve in this special ministry. But remember Jesus' response to Peter when he refused to let him wash his feet. We are all unworthy except for our salvation in Christ. You will never have a greater appreciation for the Holy Eucharist than in service to others.

Altar Servers. Youth in 5th grade and older are invited to serve. If you have previously altar served or would like to be trained to be an altar server, please contact ministries@ollparish.com and we will be in touch with further information. 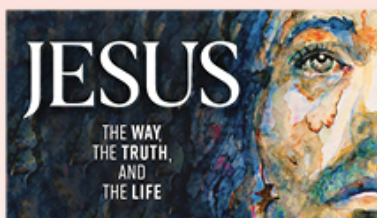


Vatican II Document: Sacred Liturgy

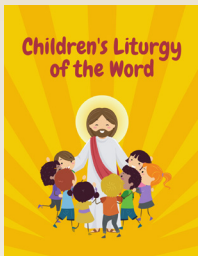

Each Sunday, we sing songs, pray together, and learn the gospel during the 9am mass. Today we learned the importance of prayer.



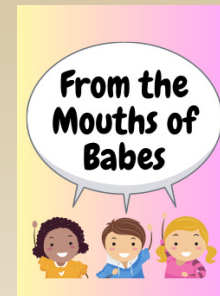
Jesus teaches his disciples how to settle disputes in the Church.

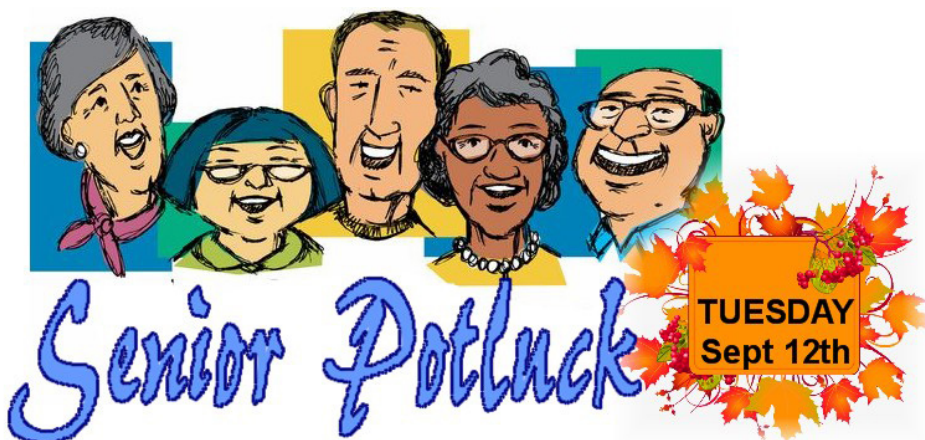
only did you help replenish these shelves time and time again, but we received comments about the high quality of the food you donated.

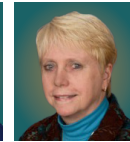
