Listening to Our Future

"Brothers and sisters: You are God's building. According to the grace of God given to me, like a wise master builder I laid a foundation, and another is building upon it. But each one must be careful how he builds upon it, for no one can lay a foundation other than the one that is there, namely, Jesus Christ."

~ 1 Corinthians 3:9c-11

L. Paul, writing to the community of believers he established in Corinth on his apostolic mission, reminded them of their "foundation" in Our Lord, Jesus Christ. Listening to the Holy Spirit, the promised Paraclete, would guide them as the community continued to grow and live into the future days. That same foundation of discernment also directs our actions as Our Lady of the Lake Parish community.

Last spring, we invited parishioners and those who volunteered to "opt-in" to complete our Community Survey regarding how we were living our parish mission as we emerged from the pandemic. The survey focused primarily on the areas of worship and faith formation. Your re-

sponses have guided our growth in these past months as participation in our child, youth, family, and adult faith formation programs has grown. Mass attendance each weekend has also increased as we strive for greater welcoming and outreach to returning parishioners and visitors. The survey results and summary are posted on the parish website. Active listening to our community members is essential for our continued healthy growth.

Parish Planning Study Survey

This past week, all registered parishioners received a letter from our pastor, Fr. John Kerns, inviting us to complete a Planning Study Survey – part of a comprehensive feasibility study of potential fundraising toward building improvements to our church and parish hall. We have once again engaged the services of the Steier Group, a Catholic development consulting firm to help

us with this planning. You may recall that they assisted us in 2016 to focus our then-capital campaign on retiring the debt on our Parish Center, completed in 2012, and to finance a new roof on the church.

With gratitude for all who participated in that fundraising effort, we are now debt-free, with a new roof and gutters on the church. Last summer, we had a successful cash campaign to add a Pre-K to our school and upgrade

our middle school facilities.



Now, before we embark on the next phase of our longrange plan, we want to hear from you, our parish family. We are ready to consider the feasibility of additional improvements to renovate our Church worship space,

and parish hall. Specifically, we are considering these projects:

- Create a New Church Entrance with a Grand Staircase and Central Elevator to provide a gathering area before and after services, better access to the main parking lot, and a combined entrance into the church (see illustration.)
- **Renovate the Church Sanctuary** to provide additional seating, improved lighting and sound, a dedicated music area, and handicapped access.
- **Renovate the Parish Hall and Kitchen** for current codes and programming flexibility, adding storage, improving restrooms, lighting, and AV capacity.
- Add an Adoration Chapel with separate entrance from the parking lot.


