### Thankful, Grateful, and Blessed

My Dear Parishioners,

In this season of Thanksgiving, I am **grateful** to God for each one of you and your families who form our parish community. I am **thankful** for the vibrant ministries that help parishioners and neighbors connect with our loving God. I am **blessed** by the ways we celebrate that connection through worship at Mass,

and through service to each other and those in need. Thusly, we are living our parish mission to:

> Love God • Love Others • Make Disciples of Jesus Christ

This is our way of being a parish. We are definitely not perfect, and we are working to improve. So, the good we do is definitely due to God's good grace.

• Last Fall we launched a Stewardship promotion to ask for an increase of financial support due to the increase of ministries

post-COVID as parishioners have returned to Mass. Parishioners responded generously to our appeal. At this point we are meeting budget.

- Last spring, we hired Krista Bryant and Melissa Hanifan to job-share the coordination of Children's Faith Formation. They re-started Children's Liturgy of the Word at the 9am Mass, Vacation Bible School and are currently running our Sunday morning programing.
- $\bullet$   $\,$  We have 80+ teens in our Confirmation program this year.
- Last spring, we conducted a general survey of our parish, and although there were suggestions for improvement, there was a strong sense of satisfaction with

how well we are fulfilling our mission. We have been working on the improvements.


- Our Pastoral Council will be working on strategies to being more welcoming, due to survey responses (constructive critiques) that spoke of the need of a more welcoming atmosphere for new attendees.
  - Our multi-faceted retreat programs, bible study groups, and returning Catholics ministries are robust and are changing lives.
  - We continue to remain active in support for those in need through our St Vincent de Paul Conference, the Sack Lunch ministry for the unhoused, and distributing grants through our Outreach program, just to mention a few.
  - Several months ago we finally paid off the \$3.6 million debt for the Parish Center (Offices & School). We are free and clear of debt. This allows us to do the next step of our Master

Plan, which is to remodel the parish hall and make some adaptations to the church.

So, at this time when I normally invite you to consider your financial stewardship to the parish, I simply want to thank you and ask that you to continue to support our regular operational funds for the parish through Sunday and online contributions. Great stuff is happening!

If your family finances allow, consider increasing your gift this year and next to meet inflation. May God continue to bless the good work, the service, and the spiritual vitality of the parishioners and staff of Our Lady of the Lake Catholic Church.
