# Behold the Lamb of God

John was standing with two of his disciples, and as he watched Jesus walk by, he said, "Behold, the Lamb of God." The two disciples heard what he said and followed Jesus. Jesus turned and saw them following him and said to them, "What are you looking for?" They said to him, "Rabbi,"—which translated means Teacher— "where are you staying?" He said to them, "Come, and you will see."

John 1:35-39

his passage from the beginning of the Gospel of John describes the call of the first disciples and takes place

in the Jordan valley, where John was baptizing. The first two to be called are disciples of John, so had joined his group of those waiting for the Messiah. They were ready when John pointed him out. Andrew, brother of Simon Peter, was one of the two, and immediately goes to tell his brother the Good News.

It is noteworthy that Jesus first calls them to be with him—Come, and you will see—and they remain with him for a time. First in our call to follow Christ comes prayer and getting to know Christ, before we can actively work for Christ and bring others to share his joy.

Only after spending time with Jesus the Teacher are we prepared to bring others to keep company with the Lord.

#### Come, and You Will See

As we begin the liturgical season of Ordinary Time in this new year, we have an invitation to reset our daily practices of prayer and spiritual reading so that we can rest in Jesus' company and learn from him. This is what disciples do—spend time with The Teacher. Young or old, children, teens, or senior adults, if we are to follow Christ, we need to make time to study his words and the example of his life. *How will you do that more regularly this year?* 

Attending Mass in-person and participating in the sacraments is a good place to listen. During the Liturgy of the Word, we hear and reflect upon a cycle of scripture readings that draw from each of the four Gospel accounts (this year, St. Mark) which are paired with passages from the Old Testa-



ment including the psalms and the prophets. Selections from the letters (epistles) of St. Paul and others provide insights

into the lives of the first disciples.

Setting a time each day for spiritual reading is easier than ever through digital app resources. Many parishioners have participated in Fr. Mike Schmitz' Bible in a Year and Catechism in a Year podcasts from Ascension Press, or Bishop Robert Barron's Word on Fire daily scripture reflections—two simple yet great ways to let your phone inspire you to take time away from social media.

propriate resources provided for children, parents, youth and adults (ollparish.com/faith-formation) These pages are regularly updated with fresh, seasonal content for individuals and families to share.

Our parish subscription to **FORMED.org** provides you with free access to their excellent Catholic print and video resources including commentaries on the Sunday scriptures, a multi-part series on the Eucharist, lives of the saints, and more. Follow the prompts on the website link above to access and explore.

There is no need to walk in faith alone. Check out the opportunities for retreats, faith-sharing groups, and weekly fellowship groups. May each of us find new ways in the new year to respond, "Here am I, Lord; I come to do your will." (Psalm 40)





In the early Church it was a common occurrence for an entire household to be baptized together. Families helped one another to know and follow Jesus. We pray that this continues to be true in our families. Before your family gathers, look around your house and gather some items that your family might have that remind you of your faith. Perhaps you have a cross or crucifix displayed in your home, a statue of Mary, a rosary or other art depicting saints. In today's Gospel we learn about how Andrew led his brother, Simon, to Jesus. Read today's Gospel, John 1:35-42. In our family life, we also help to lead one another to Jesus. Talk together about the items that you gathered, discussing what these items mean to you and how you might use them during the day for prayer. # **Portland Area Catholic Friendship Group**


