## State of Our Parish

Jesus said to them, "Come after me, and I will make you fishers of men."

Mark 1:17

#### My dear parishioners,

It has been almost 12 years since I arrived at Our Lady of the Lake as your pastor. In that time, I have witnessed incredible things in our amazing parish.

#### Spiritual Growth

We have strong adult faith formation offerings, retreat programs, bible study groups, and online outreach. Our children's and youth offerings are robust. Before and after the pandemic we continue to have Children's Liturgy of the Word, First Sacraments, Confirmation, general faith formation programming and Vacation Bible School.

#### Service to Others

We have seen an increase in our outreach to the poor. We already had a strong St. Vincent de Paul Conference, which partners at times with the Knights of Columbus to organize food drives. We have a generous Advent

Giving Tree Program and a lunch preparation program at The Father's Heart Street Ministry in Oregon City. We offer a monthly hot meal program serving our brothers and sisters who have no housing. During COVID we added the weekly sack lunch program. And for 10 years we have been "tithing" 3% of our Sunday contributions, set aside to support outside organizations engaged in the Corporal Works of Mercy, and help people in crises, like the fires in Southern Oregon and on Maui.

#### **Strong School**

Our School has become stronger. Under the leadership of Principal Corrine Buich, we received the highest accreditation marks in our history. Enrollment is full and waitlisted in most grades.

#### **Financial Stability**

Our parish is financially sound, and we are free of debt! The 2012 project to build the Parish Center (Parish Offices and School) is all paid for. We even did some remodeling two summers ago to provide a PreK classroom and adapt our middle school spaces.

#### Furthering God's Mission in the Future

God has truly blessed our community, and our parishioners are certainly generous! But there is still work to be done on our physical plant so that we can better fulfill our Mission to:

#### Love God • Love Others • Make Disciples of Jesus Christ

 Through the Community Survey last spring we learned that our parish could be more welcoming. During the fall Feasibility Study, you affirmed that the church entrances could assist that hospitality from the upstairs sanctuary to

the downstairs social space.

- The parish hall and kitchen need remodeling to better serve the community needs.
- Our church needs improvements in seating, handicap access, music ministry location, and sound system upgrades.
- We desire to have a dedicated Adoration Chapel to revere the Holy Eucharist.
- Our parish cemetery needs to be expanded to include the recently purchased adjacent property before we run out of space in the current cemetery sections.



#### The Plan

Our parish Facilities & Development Committee, which includes members of our Pastoral Council, Administrative Council and School Advisory Council, have been tracking all these matters and have advised me to move our parish forward with a new Capital Campaign to meet these needs. And so, we will.

I have hired Lynn Andrews as our Development Director to coordinate this campaign. She is a parishioner with a grandchild in our PreK. Lynn has worked in this field her entire career, including at George Fox University and Marylhurst.

The Co-Chairs of our Capital Campaign are Brian & Katie Maag and Gary & Melissa Hanifan. Both couples bring strong gifts and will develop an excellent team.

Furthermore, I have asked the Archdiocese of Portland for me to remain here as Pastor to see this project through. I have been assured that will be the case.

In this New Year we will build a New Future of proclaiming the Gospel of Jesus Christ at Our Lady of the Lake Catholic Church.





## USCCB's Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children - January 22, 2024

The Supreme Court's decision in Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization ended the nearly fifty-year nationwide reign of abortion on-demand that was ushered in by Roe v. Wade in 1973. In this monumental legal victory, the Supreme Court rightly concluded that there is nothing in the Constitution's text, history, American legal tradition, or the Court's precedents that prevents the government from protecting preborn children in the womb from the violence of abortion. Dobbs returned the issue of abortion to the people's elected representatives at the federal and state levels. And as we have seen, continuing work is needed to protect children, women, and families from the tragedy of abortion. We must continue advocating for pro-life laws and policies, especially at the state and local levels. Abortion is legal in more states than not, with many working to expand and enshrine abortion protections. In addition to our efforts to protect human life in law, we must also help women facing unexpected or difficult pregnancies, offering them the compassionate support they need to lovingly welcome the gift of their children. We must do whatever we can in every sphere to ensure the flourishing of both mothers and their children throughout life's journey.
