# The Communion of All Saints and All Souls

"God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might have eternal life."

John 3:16

In the Apostles' Creed we profess our belief in the "Communion of Saints, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting." We tend to recite those words of faith without much thought in the moment, but during November, the month of All Saints and Souls, we make time to remember and celebrate our continued connection with those who have gone before us in the faith trusting in God's promise of eternal

life through the power of His life, death, and resurrection.

During November we particularly remember parishioners, family members, friends and loved ones who have died in the past year, and all the faithful departed. The **Remembrance Scrolls** that hang in the church acknowledge and honor the names of parishioners who have passed away since last November and

whose funerals we celebrated in Church or at our parish's Sacred Heart Cemetery during the year.

During November, we invite you to record the names of family members and loved ones who have died in our **Book of Remembrance** located on the Sacred Heart altar. Take a moment during the week or before Sunday Mass to inscribe their names and pray for all the names recorded. There are also blank pages available nearby for you to take home, inscribe, return, and place in the binder.

#### Solemnity of All Saints – Friday, November 1

We will have three Masses on All Saints, Wednesday, November 1 – A holy day of obligation. Masses will be offered at 8:30 AM, Noon, and 6 PM Evening Mass. Because that day is also the First Friday of the month, we will also have Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament for Eucharistic Adoration from the conclusion of the morning Mass until 11:45 AM, and again after the Noon Mass until 5:45 PM.

### All Soul's Day Masses – Saturday, November 2

We will have two Masses celebrating All Souls Day on Saturday, November 2: at 8:30 AM, and a special Mass at 11:30 AM offered for the intention of all parishioners who have died this past year. Their names will be specifically recited during the Prayer of the Faithful. All parishioners are invited to attend the Mass to support these families in prayer. A reception for

> family members of the deceased, offered by our Funeral Luncheon Ministry, will follow the Mass in the Parish Hall. (5pm anticipated Mass will occur as usual).

## Mass for Deceased Children – Wednesday, November 6 @ 6 PM

Our annual Mass for Deceased Children will take place on Wednesday, November 6 at 6 PM. This is a special Mass and ritual

to remember children - lost at any age - and for any reason - and to support one another as we embrace these difficult memories. Our special ritual includes the chance to remember children who died in childbirth or due to miscarriage, children who died by abortion, older sons and daughters who died from diseases, accidents, or natural causes. *All parishioners are invited to attend and to support one another in prayer.* Please consider inviting someone who could be assisted by this special prayer occasion.

**Liturgical ministers:** please sign up to assist with these special Masses through the Ministry Scheduling Program.

May we always remember that God's love is everlasting! In that love, we are comforted and rejoice in our continued relationship with all our "friends in faith and family," trusting that they surround us as we remember and celebrate the mysteries of the Most Holy Eucharist. We are one in the Body of Christ.

Here are several design components being addressed by the capital campaign which launched on October 12-13 after all Masses. Each week we will highlight other components of our plans.

A Welcoming Entrance: Currently, when visitors and parishioners arrive in our parking lot and enter the parish hall lobby, it is unclear how to ascend into the church. Similarly, the A street main entrance and narthex get crowded when people ascend and enter from the narrow glass staircase. By moving the elevator and creating a new grand staircase, all attendees will have a clear path to an expanded Narthex and be able



Enhance and Refresh the Church Sanctuary. At the heart of the remodel is the refreshing of our Sanctuary. We will increase


seating and accessibility for Mass by shortening the current altar area to add more pews directly in front of the altar. This will allow us to also add a ramp to make the altar and upper sanctuary accessible for those with

disabilities. Access to seating in the loft will be restored, with two staircases and creating a structurally sound, safe, and flexible space. We will be restoring the stain glass windows, installing new flooring, updating lighting, and adding security.

and grateful to report that as of Oct. 21, we have already received \$6.2M in pledges toward our \$10M goal!






# **National Eucharistic Congress - OLL's Weekly** Video Picks




As we draw nearer to the end of 2024, the year of our National Eucharistic

change. Mercy Teams has delivered over 350,000 small acts of mercy in the form of sack lunches, hot breakfasts and family meals since the start of Covid. Mercy Teams serves our vulnerable and unsheltered guests in three primary ways:

1. Street Ministry to the Unsheltered under the Bridge, where we prepare a hot breakfast, hygiene items, sort clothing and serve our vulnerable guests with food, clothing, engagement and love. 4th Saturday Street Ministry Under the Bridge Dates: Oct. 26, Nov. 23, Dec 28.

2. Sack Lunch Meals of Mercy: we distribute 1,200 sack lunch meals every week. Sack Lunches are collected twice every month, between 9 and 11:30 outside the parish school. *Our greatest need is sack lunches.* We serve 12 missions, churches and outreach organizations each week. Please consider donating a few sack lunches during our upcoming **sack lunch collections:** October 20, November 3 & 17, and December 8 & 22. 3. **Family Meals** delivered to food insecure families— Made up by Costco and distributed prior to Thanksgiving, Christmas and Easter. Each distribution serves around 100 families.

#### **RECENT 40 DAYS FOR LIFE STORIES**

Rochester, New York: An expectant mother left Planned Parenthood, approached 40 Days for Life participants, and told them she wouldn't have the abortion... but she did have many needs-including housing, transportation, and food. So prayer warriors connected her with help. "The vigil participants put her in touch with our mom mentor, who is going to provide her with the resources she needs," wrote Rick, the longtime Rochester campaign leader.

A week later, prayer warriors observed a couple pull into the parking lot, wait for several minutes, and leave. Dorothy approached the exiting vehicle to offer a gift bag. "They revealed that they came for an abortion but changed their minds and decided to have the baby," Rick said. "Praise God!"

"Just your presence outside of an abortion clinic reduces the number of abortions as the no-show rate goes up to 75% when people are praying outside Planned Parenthood clinics." Abby Johnson, author of Unplanned and former Planned Parenthood clinic director.

# Did you know that 40 Days for Life is International?

**Tunja, Colombia:** An older mother was referred for an abortion because her age allegedly made the pregnancy "high risk." As the mom arrived at the abortion facility, she was moved by the presence of 40 Days for Life volunteers and told them about her situation. Vigil participants offered their support. A priest offered her a special blessing. The woman decided to proceed with her pregnancy. "However the baby comes, it is welcome," she told prayer warriors. "You have changed my life!" 40daysforlife.com.
