The Nicene Creed

I believe in one God, the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible.

Priest: The Lord be with you.


All: And with your spirit.

Priest: Lift up your hearts.


All: We lift them up to the Lord.

All: It is right and just.




Due to the absence of kneelers, please remain standing for the Eucharistic Prayer, and bow when the priest genuflects at the altar after the consecration.


Priest: Deliver us, Lord...

Lamb of God, you take a-way the sins of the world, have mer - cy,



behold him who takes away the sins of the world. Blessed are those called to the supper of the Lamb.


