

#### The Nicene Creed

I believe in one God, the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible.

I believe in one Lord Jesus Christ, the Only Begotten Son of God, born of the Father before all ages. God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, consubstantial with the Father; through him all things were made. All: May the Lord accept the sacrifice at your hands, for the praise and glory of his name, for our good and the good of all his Holy Church.


#### THE EUCHARISTIC PRAYER

Priest: The Lord be with you. All: And with your spirit. Priest: Lift up your hearts.


All: We lift them up to the Lord.


