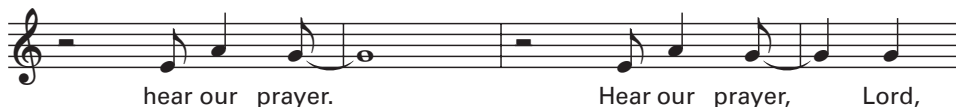

The Lord's Prayer

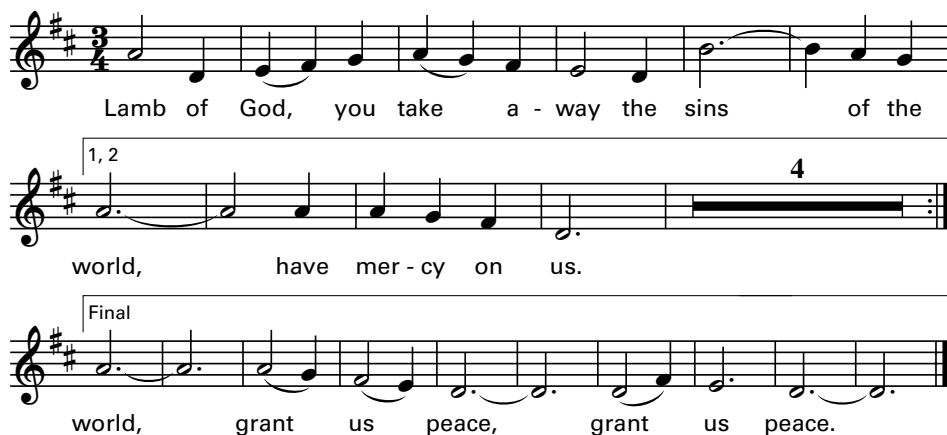
