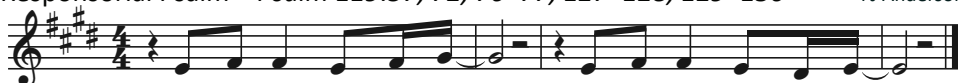

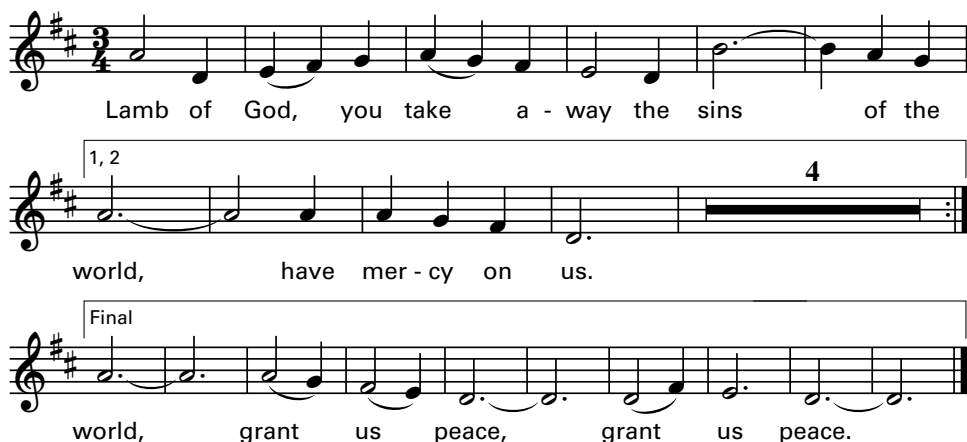
The Lord's Prayer

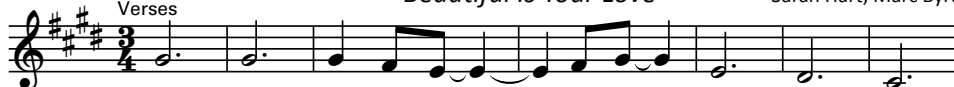

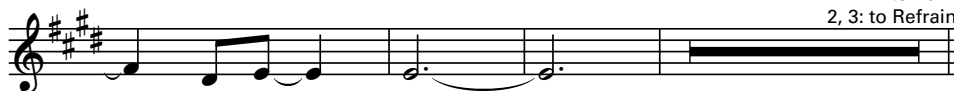
