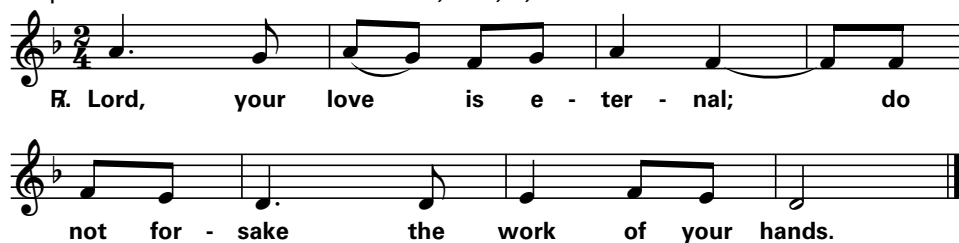

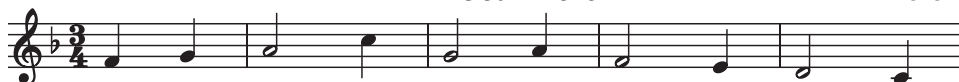

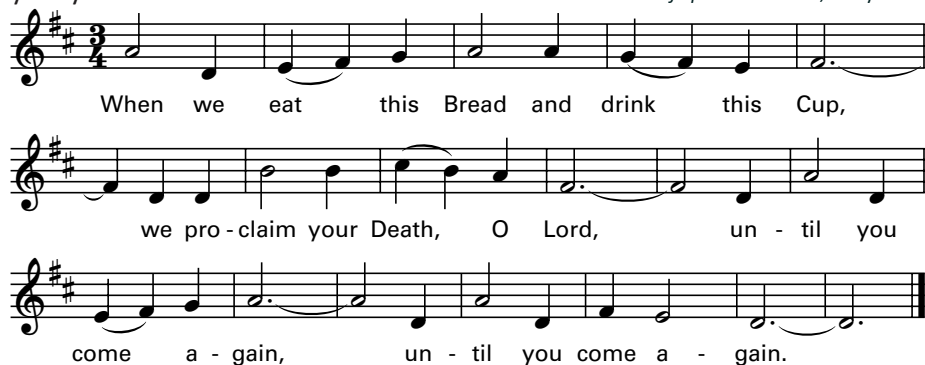

The Lord's Prayer

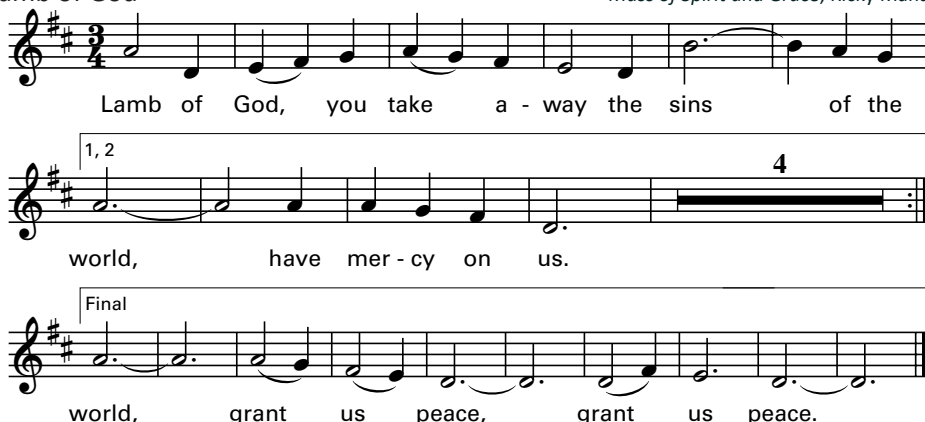

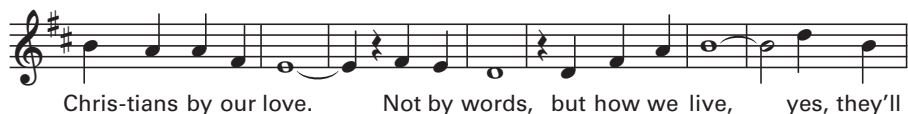

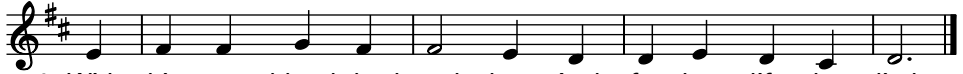
