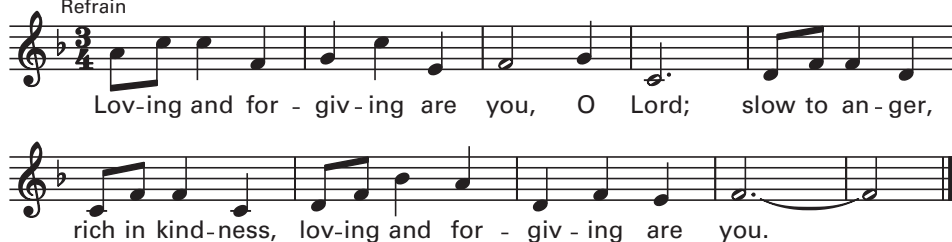

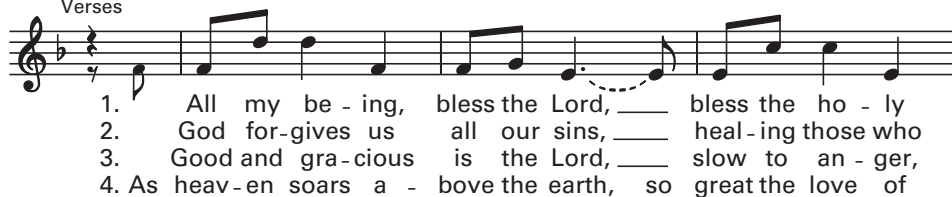

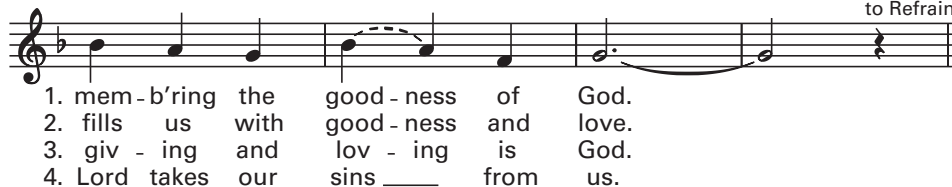

The Lord's Prayer

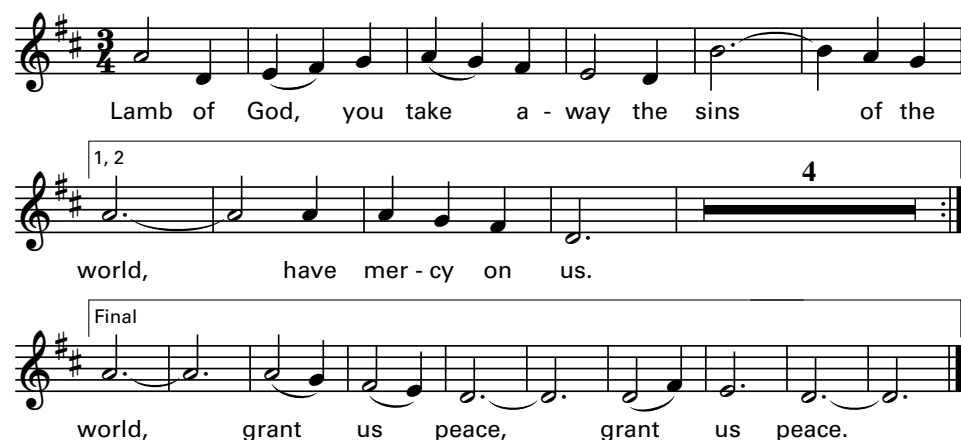
