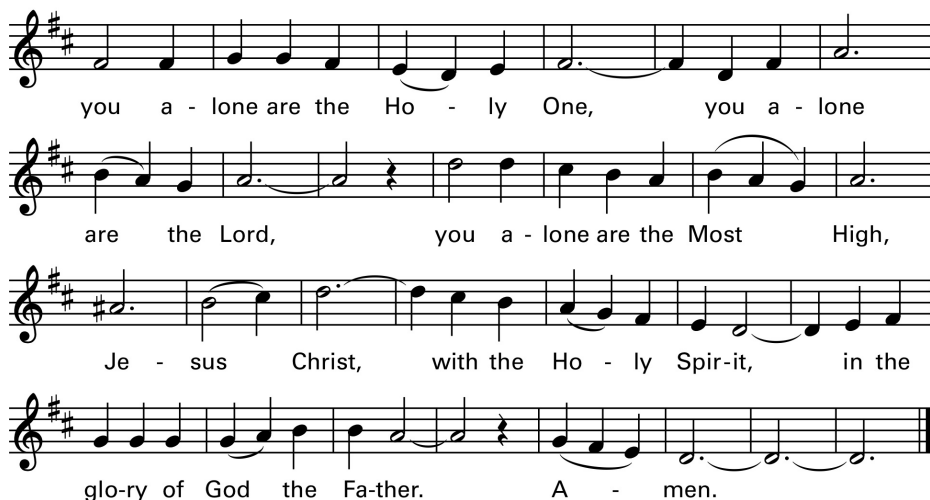

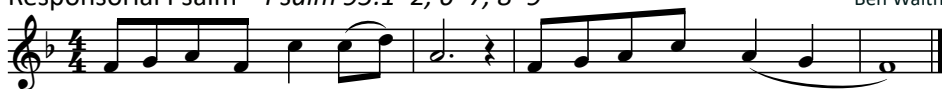

The Lord's Prayer

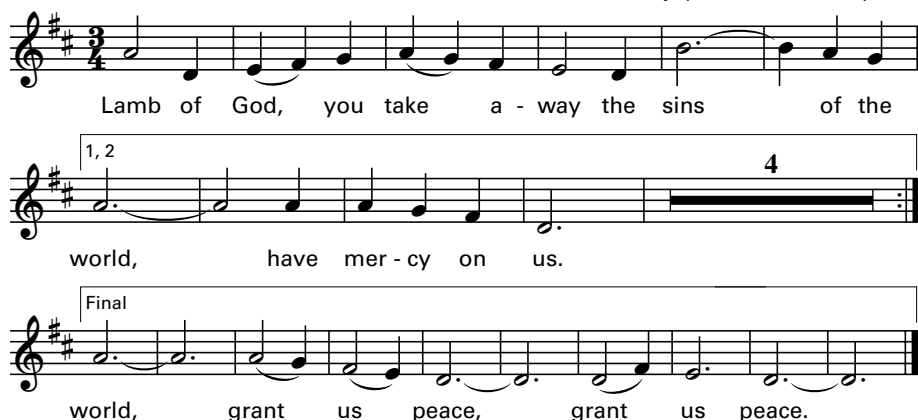
